

Copy of extract of Resolution No. 21 of the Executive Council's meeting held on 15.06.2015 and follow up action report vide Resolution No. 2(21) of the Executive Council's meeting held on 03.08.2015.

Considered the recommendations of the Academic Council made vide Resolution No. 19 of its meeting held on 05.06.2015, based on recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to consider the Resolution No. 3 of the Academic Council's meeting dated 11.07.2014 that the following amendments in the common Ordinances of 1-year courses, 2-year courses, 3-year courses 4-year courses, 5-year integrated courses (semester system) and 6-year integrated courses excluding Engg., M.Phil. Ph.D., Medical and Ayurveda courses be amended as under **with effect from the session 2015-16:-**
Common Ordinance for 2 year (PG) courses:

<p><u>Clause-10</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examination in each semester shall be: (i) 40% (50% for M.Pharma.) in each theory paper. (ii) 40% (50% for M.Pharma.) in each practical examination or viva-voce/ project/training report/dissertation wherever prescribed. (iii) 40% (50% for M.Pharma.) in the aggregate of sessionals/internals and examination for each theory and practical subject.</p>	<p><u>Clause-10</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examination in each semester shall be: (i) 40% (50% for M.Pharma.) in each theory paper. (ii) 40% (50% for M.Pharma.) in each practical examination or viva voce/ project/training report/ dissertation wherever prescribed. (iii) 40% in the aggregate of sessionals/ internal assessment and examination for each theory and practical subject.</p> <p><u>Clause 11 (ii)</u> A candidate shall be promoted to the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester automatically but for promotion to 3rd semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st semester and for promotion to 5th semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st, 2nd and 3rd semesters taken together, subject to fulfilment of conditions as laid down in clause-7 above.</p>	<p><u>Clause-9</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examinations in each semester shall be: (i) 40% in each theory paper. (ii) 40% in each practical examination or viva voce/project/training report/ dissertation wherever prescribed. (iii) 40% in aggregate of <u>each theory paper and internal assessment (and practical where practical is a component of theory paper).</u></p> <p><u>Clause 11 (ii)</u> A candidate shall be promoted to the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester automatically but for promotion to 3rd semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st semester and for <u>promotion to 5th semester, he/she must complete all his 1st semester papers,</u> subject to fulfilment of conditions as laid down in clause-7 above. <u>Note: For the purpose of promotion, each theory and practical in any subject shall be considered as separate paper.</u></p>

Common Ordinance 4 year courses:

<p><u>Clause-9</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examinations in each semester shall be: For B.Pharmacy course</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) 50% in theory paper (including sessionals and attendance) (ii) 50% in practicals (including sessionals and attendance) (iii) 50% in aggregate. <p><u>Clause 11 (ii)</u> A candidate shall get promoted to the next semester/class automatically subject to fulfilment of the conditions as prescribed in Clause-7 above. However, in Engineering and Pharmacy Course, candidates will be promoted to the Fifth semester if he/she has passed at least 50% papers of all the previous three semesters. Candidates are required to fulfil the eligibility conditions for appearing in the examination of lower semester.</p> <p>Note: xx xx xx</p>	<p><u>Clause-9</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examinations in each semester shall be: For B.Pharmacy course</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>50% in each theory paper.</u> (ii) <u>50% in each practical examination or viva voce/project/training report/dissertation wherever prescribed.</u> (iii) <u>50% in aggregate of each theory paper and internal assessment (and practical where practical is a component of theory paper).</u> <p><u>Clause 11 (ii)</u> A candidate shall get promoted to the next semester/class automatically subject to fulfilment of the conditions as prescribed in Clause-7 above. <p><u>Clause-5</u> The minimum pass marks for passing any examinations shall be as under:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) 40% in each theory paper, including internal assessment/sessionals wherever prescribed. (ii) 40% in each practical examination, viva-voce, project training report, dissertation, including internal assessment/sessionals wherever prescribed. <p><u>Clause-12</u> Module -I (1st to 6th semesters): The candidate shall be treated as promoted to the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester automatically but for promotion to 3rd semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st semester and for promotion to 5th semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st, 2nd and 3rd semesters taken together subject to fulfilment of conditions as laid down in Clause-9 above, unless detained from appearing in an examination on any genuine grounds.</p>	<p><u>Clause-5</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examinations in each semester shall be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>40% in each theory paper.</u> (ii) <u>40% in each practical examination or viva voce/project/training report/dissertation wherever prescribed.</u> (iii) <u>40% in aggregate of each theory paper and internal assessment (and practical where practical is a component of theory paper).</u> <p><u>Clause-12</u> Module -I (1st to 6th semesters): The candidate shall be treated as promoted to the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester automatically but for promotion to 3rd semester, he/she must clear 50% papers of 1st semester and for <u>promotion to 5th semester, he/she must complete all his/her 1st semester papers,</u> subject to fulfilment of conditions as laid down in Clause-9 above, unless detained from appearing in an examination on any genuine grounds.</p>

(iii) 40% in the aggregate of sessionals/internal assessment and examination for each theory and practical subject.</p> <p><u>Clause-12 (ii)</u> The candidate shall be promoted to the next semester/class automatically subject to fulfilment of the conditions as prescribed in Clause-8 above.</p>	<p><u>Clause-10</u> The minimum percentage of marks to pass the examinations in each semester shall be: (i) 40% in each theory paper. Ordinance for 1 year courses: There are several ordinances for one year courses such as diploma/degree/certificate programmes and the pass percentage is prescribed through various clauses in various ordinances. Therefore, the common amendment as under be implemented in all 1-year ordinances
