The objective is to introduce to the student Disaster Management as an academic as well as professional field. The students will be familiarized with theoretical, fundamental, regional, practical, legal and financial aspects, risk assessment and its reduction, preparedness planning, vulnerability assessment, analyze and execute the operational aspects of assessing, planning and implementing health hazard prevention and care intervention in emergencies, recent trends and Governmental and Non-Governmental practices for disaster management in India.

Courses:

1. PG Diploma in Disaster Studies and Management
Two semesters Course (Spread over in one year (12 months))
2. M. A. / M.Sc. in Disaster Studies and Management
3. Ph.D. Programme.

Eligibility: B.A./B.Sc. in Geography, Geology, Environmental Sciences, Botany, Zoology, Public Administration, Economics, Psychology, Sociology and other relevant subjects from a recognized University.

Admission: Through entrance examination.

Intake capacity:

- i) PG Diploma-20
- ii) M.A./M.Sc.-15
- iii) Ph.D.-As per available faculty

Candidate can opt Certificate in Disaster Studies and Management on successful completion of One Semester. Similarly candidate will be awarded Post Graduate Diploma in Disaster Studies and Management on Successful Completion of Two Semesters of the Course, if so desired. The MA/M.Sc. Degree will be awarded on successful completion of all the Four Semesters of the course


