#### Abstract

The abstract should summarize the content of the paper. Try to keep the abstract below 150 words. Do not have references or displayed equations in the abstract. Paper form is a necessary condition for its publication, as well as its content.

*Keywords:* Author Guide, Article, Camera-Ready Format, Paper Specifications, Paper Submission.

#### 1. Introduction

The text must be in English. The submitted typeset scripts of each contribution must be in their final form and of good appearance because they will be printed directly. This document is set in 10-point Times New Roman.

#### 2. Headings and Footnotes

1. Major headings are to be column centered in a bold font without underline. They should be numbered. 2. 'Headings and Footnotes' at the top of the paragraph is the main heading with the <u>font size 12 of Times New Roman</u>.

#### 2.1 Subheadings

Subheadings should be same as the above headings "2.1 Subheadings" with font size 11. They should start at the left-hand margin on a separate line.

The top of this paragraph illustrates a subheading.

Title: The title should be centered across the top of the first

page and should have a distinctive <u>font of 18 points Century</u>. It should be in bold font and in lower case with initial capitals.

Author' Name and Address: The authors' names and addresses should be centered below the title. These lines should be 9 points Times New Roman.

**Keywords:** From 4 to 6 keywords should follow the abstract as a subheading: *Key words*, of the Abstract.

**Illustrations or pictures:** All halftone illustrations or pictures should be clear black and white prints. Supply the best quality/high resolution illustrations or pictures possible.

#### 2.1 Footnotes

Footnotes should be typed in single-line spacing at the bottom of the page and column where it is cited. Footnotes should be rare.
