ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Food safety is an important social and health priority for any country. Rising incomes and urbanization, rising instances of food borne health hazards, an expanding domestic consumer base concerned about food quality and safety, emerging global standards and regulations and rapidly growing agricultural exports and polluted farming have been important drivers for the increased attention to food safety. With the advent of risk based approaches, new standards at national as well as global level and shifting trends from regulatory to self compliance practices have given a new insight and redefined the food safety. In India, the food processing industry holds tremendous opportunity. It has high employment potential, can boost exports of agro-products out of the country, and also

provide better returns to farmers for their produce. However, this is possible only if food safety standards are effectively enforced in the country. Addressing food safety concerns in India will require adoption of appropriate legislation, strengthening capacity to enforce rules, promoting adoption of good agricultural, manufacturing and hygiene practices, greater collective action, and some targeted investments. The expert speakers from diverse fields including government regulatory bodies, academics and private agencies devoted for food safety management have been invited to deliberate upon the issues related to food safety and exchange their valuable ideas. The deliberations in this seminar will focus on food safety issues in food chain from farm to fork, emerging food safety concerns, emerging standards, practices and new approaches for the safety management systems at national as well as global level. The outcomes of the discussions/deliberations will definitely be beneficial for the food chain stakeholders as well as policy makers.
