5. All the participants will be awarded a certificate of participation.

7. Verdict of the judges will be final. No protest or objection with regards to either the decision or the procedure will be entertained.
8. Admission to the debate will be subject to the presentation of a letter of the credentials from the head of the institution certifying the bonafide status of the participants.
9. Speaking order of the participating teams shall be decided on the spot.
10. Participants may be accompanied by teacher-in-charge.
11. Competitors with written debates will not be eligible for prizes.
