The aim of this FDP on “**MOOCs AND E- LEARNING TECHNOLOGIES**” is to create the awareness among faculty members from HEIs about Massive open online courses (MOOCs) on Study Webs of Active- Learning by Young and Aspiring Minds (SWAYAM) platform and various e-learning technologies. Educational and learning technology has obtained great importance over the last few years. At present, the umbrella of educational technology incorporates varieties of engaging online environments and fields. E-learning technologies and MOOCs are the most relevant emerging topics. Since they are open to everyone at no cost, MOOCs surpass in attracting the masses as it can reach to hundreds of thousands participants. Nevertheless, a concern often is raised about MOOCs is that a very small proportion of learners complete the course while thousands enroll for courses.

In this programme, the main objective is to sensitize the participants about MOOCs and train them to design and develop and deliver such courses in their respective domain area of knowledge. This programme will also discuss the issues related to the introduction of online courses through SWAYAM as part of the curriculum in University and Colleges.

Learning Outcomes of FDP

With practical sessions and practice of various digital platforms, they will be in position to integrate technology with teaching pedagogy. The higher education institutions will also get benefits by the knowledge of digitally equipped faculty members in achieving its aims. This FDP will certainly help in enhancement of professional development of teachers which is going to affect the students learning indirectly. The participants will be learning through group activities and collaborative learning experiences with theoretical and hands on sessions covering the various aspects of MOOCs ecosystem. The knowledge and competency to use various Learning Management Systems(LMS) will equip the faculty members in designing, developing and delivering their own online courses. Other e- learning technologies will help the teachers in long run to deliver online sessions and sharing the knowledge over networks.
