Item No-1

Logo of the Centre: The Logo would be needed for the Centre. The members resolved that the Centre may invite Logo Designs from various stakeholders through an open invitation on the University website giving 15 days time. The logo should be of minimum 300dpi and colorful, keeping in view academic spirit and size should not be more than 10MB. An encouragement amount of Indian Rupees Five Thousand One Hundred Only (5,100/-) may be given to the logo selected. A jury may be constituted to select the same encompassing of Three - Five Members.

Offering Courses in Foundation & Open Electives: It was resolved that in view of approved blueprint of Centre, initially Two Papers may be offered for Post Graduate Programmes as Foundation Elective & Open Elective with immediate effect. Offering Online/ Blended Workshops: It was resolved that the centre may plan some workshops on Life Skills & Communication Skills for Learners of the University initially and then open for other stakeholders later. In the first stage, the same shall be taken with faculty/ departments offering professional programmes and then for faculty/departments offering other programmes. This shall be conducted involving team from CLAS, Faculty Members from Concerned Department and Identified External Resource Persons.
