Sir/Madam,

It is to bring to your kind notice that the hostel accommodation will be provided to the students of UTDs with the following conditions:-


- The students admitted through LEET under all AICTE approved courses and whose examinations are to be held along with intermediate semesters from 03.03.2021 may be allowed admission to hostels for the limited purpose of examinations only. Applications of those LEET students will be considered whose residence is beyond 30 km away for Girls and 50 km away for Boys.
- All M. Pharm final year scholars who are required to do project work and submit their thesis, as per Ordinance, may be allowed to work in laboratories of the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences and allowed admission to hostels till 30.06.2021.
- The student should submit RT-PCR (COVID-19) negative test report conducted within 72 hour before the admissions to the hostels.
- If a resident after taking admission stays away from the hostel **more than three days**, He/She will have to submit RT-PCR (COVID-19) negative test report again, conducted within 72 hour before re-entering the hostel.
- The Hostel admission form should be forwarded by the concerned Head/Director of the Department/Institute/Centre along with No Objection certificate from the parents.
- The hostel accommodation shall be provided only to the students who will appear offline in the intermediate exams to be held in March 2021.
- The reservation criteria as per Haryana Government guidelines need to be followed.
- Hostel accommodation will be provided only to those students who shall appear in the intermediate semester exams starting from 03.03.2021 through offline mode.
- Students expelled during the past from M.D.U Hostels are not eligible to apply.



 a) The students admitted through I.E.E.T under all AICTE approved courses and whose examinations are to be held along with intermediate semester from 03.03.2021 may be allowed to stay in hostel for the limited purpose of examinations only. Applications of those I.E.E.T students whose residence is beyond 30 km away for Girls and 50 km away for Boys.
 b) All M. Pharm final year scholars who are required to do project work and submit their thesis as per Ordinance may be allowed to work in laboratories of the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences and allowed admission to hostels till 30.06.2021.
 c) The student should submit RT-PCR (COVID-19) negative test report conducted within 72 hour before the admissions to the hostels.
 d) If a resident after taking admission stays away from the hostel more than three days, Hostel will have to submit RT-PCR (COVID-19) negative test report again, conducted within 72 hour before re-entering the hostel.
 e) The Hostel admission form should be forwarded by the concerned Head/Director of the Department/Institute Centre along with No Objection certificate from the parents.
 f) The hostel accommodation shall be provided only to the students who will appear offline in the intermediate exams to be held in March 2021.
 g) The reservation criteria as per Haryana Government guidelines need to be followed.
 h) Hostel accommodation will be provided only to those students who shall appear in the intermediate semester exams starting from 03.03.2021 through offline mode.
 i) Students expelled during the past from M.D.U Hostels are not eligible to apply.
