Sub.: Proceedings of the meeting of the Committee regarding to admission in PhD Programme under the supernumerary seat.

A meeting of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor comprising of the following was held on 02.03.2021 at 02:30 pm in the Committee Room, Department of Psychology, M.D. University, Rohtak regarding to admission in PhD Programme under the supernumerary seat in the Department of Political Science:-

Matter was discussed and it was observed that the case is not covered under the existing provisions of supernumerary seats. However, in view of recommendations of HOD, Political Science, it was resolved that candidate may be asked to submit her educational record to ascertain the eligibility. It was also resolved that a similar case lying pending with Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences may also be taken up with this case in next meeting on 04.03.2021.

Committee members met again on 04.03.2021 and it was observed that-

- (i) Two cases i.e. (1) Ms. Namrata Singh, Political Science and (2) Ms. Geeta Sharma, Psychology are almost parallel and can be considered together.
- (ii) The existing provisions of Prospectus 2020-21 of MDU for admission to M.Phil/PhD programme in case of supernumerary seats do not cover the above two cases.
- (iii) However, the intent of rules pertaining to supernumerary seats seems to grant opportunities to the otherwise eligible candidates for educational progression in the larger interest of students, community and society with the super ordinate objective of educational institutes to maximise opportunities to translate the knowledge into action at study, work and living places for benefit of one and all.
- (iv) Keeping the intent of the supernumerary seats in view it was further observed that the availability of number of seats under the respective supervisors (Prof. Rajendra Sharma, Professor in Political Science and Prof. Anjali Malik, Professor in Psychology) are within limit as per Clause-12 of the Ordinance and they have consented to supervise the respective candidates i.e. (Ms Namrata Singh, Pol. Science and Geeta Sharma, Psychology). The respective Heads (HOD, Political Science and HOD, Psychology) have recommended the cases for the admission to PhD Programme against the supernumerary seats and both have certified that admissions in PhD Programme against the different categories of supernumerary seats are NIL except one each for Foreign/NRI students.

In view of the above observations, it is recommended that:-

- (1) Ms. Namrata Singh may be allowed admission to PhD Programme (Political Science) 2020-21 by condoning delay against supernumerary seat under the supervision of

Prof. Rajendra Sharma. HOD, Pol. Science will ensure that student admitted must complete a 30 days modular PhD Course Work laid down in prospectus at Page 32 and pay the fee applicable to supernumerary seat as specified in Chapter- VIII, Page-44 of prospectus.

- (2) Ms. Geeta Sharma may be allowed admission to PhD Programme 2020-21 (Psychology) against supernumerary seat under the supervision of Prof. Anjali Malik. The candidate is a M.Phil degree holder from K.U.K., therefore, she is exempted from the PhD Course Work, however, HOD, Psychology will ensure that she pays the fee as specified in Chapter-VIII, Page-44 of prospectus applicable to supernumerary seats.

It is submitted that the recommendations (1 and 2) may be allowed as one time exemption in PhD programme 2020-21 as special cases.

It is also submitted that scope of provisions of supernumerary seats in the MDU offered programme may be revisited before the admission of 2021-22 to enlist and maximise the objective of imparting of knowledge across the global.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
