NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 3rd September, 2021

S.O. 3605(E)—In exercise of powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 34 of the National Highways Act, 1956 (49 of 1956) (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), being satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest that any or any class of persons be prohibited from building (including flyovers etc.), maintenance, management and operation of NH 11A in the stretch of land from km. 1.00 to km. 15.00 (Panthkot-Mandi section) in the district of KANGRA in the state of HIMACHAL PRADESH, hereby directs it is necessary to declare that any person who contravenes the provisions of the Act in the manner mentioned hereinbelow shall be liable to a fine of two thousand rupees for the first offence and five thousand rupees for every subsequent offence.

Every such objection shall be made to the Competent Authority, namely, Sub Divisional Officer (C), Jalandhar in writing and shall set out the grounds thereof and the Competent Authority shall give written notice to the concerned authority of being satisfied in person or by a representative and may direct that such objections and other such further enquiry, if any, as the Competent Authority thinks necessary, by order, either allow or disallow the objections.

Any order made by the Competent Authority under sub-section (2) of section 3C of the said Act shall be final.

Haryana Home and Health Minister Anil Vij today said that the state government is ready for an impartial probe (in connection with Karnal fatality incident) but the probe would not be limited to the SDM (Aiyash Singh) only but would cover the entire Karnal episode.

Responding to media queries, the minister said, "Farmers have been protesting in Karnal. It is their democratic right and our officials are in constant dialogue with the farmers. Dialogue is an integral part of any democracy, but only legitimate demands will be accepted. We cannot hang anyone because someone is demanding it. Are the IPC (Indian Penal Code) of the country and the IPC of the farmers different? Punishment is given according to the offence."
