

CONCEPT NOTE REGARDING FORMULATION OF INNOVATION AND STARTUP POLICY OF THE UNIVERSITY

The transformation to entrepreneurial economy has been accompanied by growing interest in entrepreneurship among the students, as well as increased recognition within corporate sector. In tune with initiatives of Government of India i.e. National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP), 2019 and National Education Policy (NEP), 2020, the formulation of MDU-Innovation and Startup Policy (MISP) is in progress as a mandatory exercise as well as necessary for the growth of the university.

The policy guidelines shall enable active support to the faculty, staff and students to participate in innovation and entrepreneurship (I&E) related activities, thus encouraging innovators to consider start ups and entrepreneurship as a career option. These guidelines shall also emphasize that the entrepreneurship is all about creating a business, which is financially successful.

Objectives

The proposed MDU-Innovation and Startup Policy (MISP) has following key objectives :

- To nurture the ideas of the students and faculty in an effective manner so as to convert them in successful startups and entrepreneurial ventures
- To shift the focus of the stakeholders from "being employee" to "become employer"
- To nurture an IPR savvy environment for creation of Intellectual Property and protection of IPRs and technology transfer to the Industry
- To facilitate channelization of University innovations into start-ups through incubation to become a wheel of Socio-economic development and of national progress
- To develop skilled manpower needed for the emerging requirements of the Industry.

In this regard, it is a mandate that the university should define the thrust areas or priority areas in which there are great potential of emergence of innovative ideas which can be successfully converted in to startups and entrepreneurial ventures. It would be appropriate if the thrust/priority areas are decided in line with,

1. Vision and mission of the university
2. Facilities and strength of the university
3. Emerging potential areas
4. Local/National needs of the society
5. National initiatives of Govt of India
