

## Minutes of the 29<sup>th</sup> July meeting for Har Ghar Tiranga events for compliance and follow up actions

The Vice-Chancellor chaired a meeting in the conference room of his office at 4:00p.m. on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to confabulate the arrangements for 'Har Ghar Tiranga' programs to be organized in the University and other designated places from 13<sup>th</sup> August 2022 to 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The following functionaries attended the meeting:

The following were resolved in the meeting:

1. A special event shall be organized to initiate the drive for inspiring and exhibiting nationalism at the Sports Ground from 10a.m. to 11a.m. on 13<sup>th</sup> August 2022 wherein 7500 volunteer students shall participate in the Rashtriya Dhvaj Vandana. Each participant shall carry the national flag and move in the procession upon conclusion of the event. The route of the procession shall be charted by the organizing committee under the chairmanship of the Registrar and members would be the DSW, Director Sports, Program Coordinator NSS, Executive Engineer, YRC Program Coordinator and Chief Security Officer. The exit of the procession shall be from Gate No. 1. The concerned officers would ensure that a minimum of 2000 student volunteers come from YRC, 2000 from NSS, 1000 from NCC, 500 from Sports, 250 each from NRS Govt. College and Jat College, 200 students each from MKJK Mahavidyalaya, Govt. College for Women, Rohtak, Gaur Brahmin College, L.N. Hindu College, and University Campus School. Apart from these, a minimum of 500 students would participate from Vaish Institutions and Saini College. They will be invited by the Dean, College Development Council by ensuring their participation. National Flags for each volunteer would be arranged by the DSW and instructions would be imparted to them to raise the flags with utmost reverence. **For actions by the Registrar; Dean Students' Welfare; Coordinator, Youth Red Cross; Program Coordinator, NSS; I/c., NCC; Director Sports; Dean, College Development Council; and Director, University Campus School.**

2. The event at the Sports Ground shall commence with recitation of *Rastragan* and the conductors of the event would be DSW and DYW for half an hour. Recitation of some nationalistic songs would be arranged. The event and procession would be covered by drone cameras and still photography as well as video recordings. The D.R. Gen Admin would make a request to the district administration for permitting use of low flying drones for recording the events for all the three days, i.e. from 13<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> Aug. The Executive Engineer shall make arrangements for drinking water there. The security personnel and sanitation staff would be deployed by the concerned officers in sufficient number at the Sports Ground and on way. They will also move besides the procession to ensure safety and security as well as cleanliness and promptly collect any misplaced flag respectfully to deposit the same with Gen Admin. The procession will move for half an hour on the campus. **For actions by the Dean Students' Welfare, Director Sports; Director, Youth Welfare; D.R. (Gen Admin); Executive Engineer; Chief Security Officer.**

3. The Executive Engineer shall ensure raising the flags on all 300 poles spread over the University Campus. Besides these, all the University buildings shall hoist national flags of big size. All the households located in the University Campus shall be provided national flags that will be hoisted at the rooftops or other prominent places by the residents. Both the gates at the

Delhi Road would also hoist national flags. The DCDC would motivate all the Directors and Principals of affiliated institutes to hoist flags in their institutions and also urge them to encourage and mobilize their students to hoist national flags on their houses. **For actions by the Executive Engineer, Dean, College Development Council and D.R. (Gen Admin).**

4. The DSW and DYW would ensure participation of a minimum of 50 persons from each of the 5 villages adopted by the University for the event *Rashtriya Dhwaj Vandan*. They will also be mobilized for hoisting flags in their respective places. **For actions by the DSW and DYW.**

5. The Director Sports will arrange beautification and decoration of the ground and adjoining areas and he will also maintain discipline there. The General Administration would ensure cleanliness in the entire campus area. **For actions by the Director Sports and D.R. (Gen Admin).**

6. The Program Coordinator YRC would arrange two First Aid Posts for males and females separately near the Yagyashala where ambulance would also be stationed. The entire staff of Health Centre shall remain present there. **For actions by the Program Coordinator YRC, DSW and Doctor I/c. University Health Centre.**

7. The events of 15<sup>th</sup> August would be jointly conducted by the Director, University Campus School, D.R. Gen Admin and DYW. The cultural programs would be staged in the Radha Krishanan Auditorium after flag hoisting at Tagore Auditorium. **For actions by the Director, University Campus School, D.R. (Gen Admin) and DYW.**

The proceedings of the meeting have been approved by the Vice-Chancellor with the orders that all the concerned officers shall ensure timely action and follow up.
