Long weekend, tourists ne for Shimla

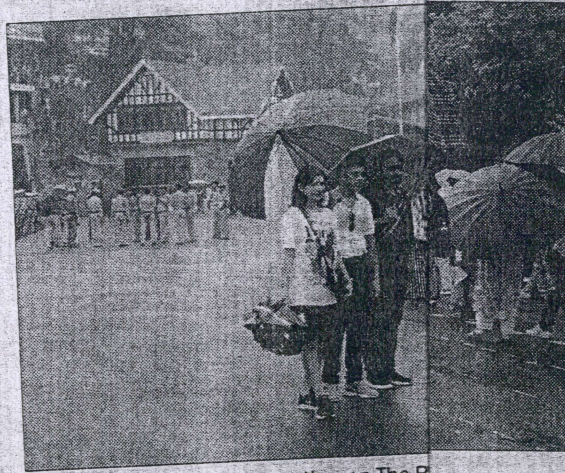

Tourists are making a beeline for the queen of hills, Shimla, in spite of frequent landslides on the Shimla-Parwanoo Highway. With the long I-Day weekend going on, the hotels in the city have recorded 80-90 per cent occupancy.

"It is a big relief from the sultry heat of plains and we are enjoying the rain and cold weather. The fog is presenting a mesmerising view of the hills," said Mohit and Anu, a tourist couple from Delhi.

President of the Tourism Industry Stakeholders Association MK Seth said 90 per cent rooms had been booked in premium hotels while the overall occupancy was between 80 and 90 per cent. The footfall could have been

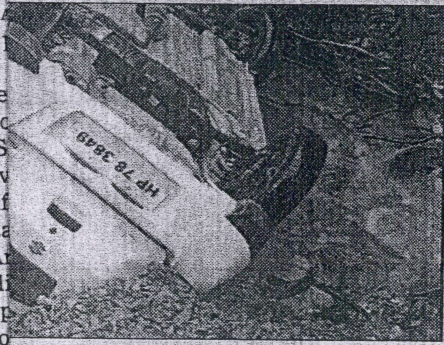

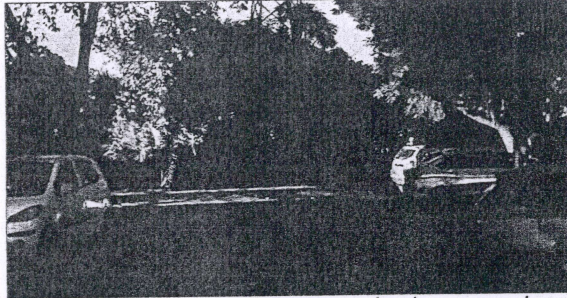

Streetlights defunct: Streets here a nightmare for riders after dark

Gurgaon: Non-functional streetlights have become a serious cause of concern for residents of Malibu Towne in Sector 47. The residents claimed that around 30 lanes and by-lanes are engulfed in complete darkness post sunset as around 200 streetlights are lying defunct for the last one month. Even after the transfer of colony to MCG in June, there is no end to the suffering when it comes to ensuring adequate basic amenities in the colony, the residents al-

the society, but we are still awaiting basic amenities," he said.

Motorists too are having a hard time while commuting through poorly lit streets. Vijay Shiv Nath, president of Malibu Towne RWA said that around 2,700 families in the township are living under constant threat in the absence of functioning streetlights. "Women, children and senior citizens are worst affected here, even the motorists are facing the risk of accident with stray animals roaming around without proper lights. No one from the MCG is bothered to check if cables are faulty or switching panel or lights needs to be changed altogether." Vicky Kumar, executive engineer, MCG said, "We have already awarded the contract and the agency will start taking care of the street-light soon."

leged. They claimed to have made several complaints to the civic body.

Pradeep Kumar Vaid, one of the residents, said that they avoid going out unnecessarily after sunset as the streets are not safe with no proper illumination. "Usually we avoid going out and if we have to, we find our ways with light from mobile.

Roads are already in bad condition with uneven surface and during monsoon it become dangerous too with harmful reptiles and insects coming out in open making it difficult to spot them with no lights. Several incidents of theft in the neighbourhood have been reported. We thought things would improve once MCG takes over

2 Bangladeshis held for making fake passports

New Delhi: Delhi Police has arrested two Bangladeshi nationals for making fake passports in the city.

The accused were identified as Mohammad Mostafa (28) and Mohammad Husain Sheikh. They both were living in Palam Extension area. DCP (Dwarka) M Harsaha Vardhan said they are conducting a checking drive.

"The vendors and shopkeepers in the area are being briefed to inform the police about anything suspicious," he said.

During one such drive, police got information about two Bangladeshi nationals. "On search, 11 passports of different Bangladeshi citizens, 10 fake stamps of various ministries and notary of Bangladesh were seized," police said.

The accused told cops that they were agents for Bangladeshi nationals who come for medical treatment in the city. A case under foreigners act as well as Section 468 (forgery for purpose of cheating) of Indian Penal Code (IPC) was registered and further investigation was going on.
