The body of former Telecom Minister Pandit Sukh Ram reached his native place here this evening. His relatives and acquaintances started gathering at his residence on the outskirts of the town to offer their condolences to the bereaved family. The funeral would be held tomorrow.

The body would be kept at Seri Manch on Thursday morning for people to pay their last respects to the departed soul before being taken for funeral. Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur and many other senior leaders of the BJP and the Congress are expected to attend the funeral.

Sukh Ram was on the life-support system at AIIMS for the past two days. Ashray Sharma confirmed his grandfather's death on his Facebook account early this morning. "End of an era. Alveda Dada, ab sahi boya-ge phone ki ghanti (Good-bye

Dada ji, now, the bell of your phone will not ring".

Sukh Ram was born at Kothi village in Mandi district on July 27, 1927. In 1962, he became a member of the Territorial Council of Himachal Pradesh. He served as the Union Minister for Communications and Information Technology from 1983 to 1996.

He was a member of the Lok Sabha from the Mandi parliamentary constituency. He won the Vidhan Sabha elections five times and the Lok Sabha elections thrice. In 2011, he was sentenced to five years jail in the telecom scam.

Sukh Ram represented the Mandi Assembly seat from 1962 to 1984. He was elected to the Lok Sabha in 1984 and served as a junior minister in the Rajiv Gandhi government. He had also served as the Minister of State for Defence Production and Supplies, Planning and Food and Civil Supplies.

He won the Mandi Lok Sabha seat in 1996, but was expelled from the Congress along with his son Anil Sharma after the telecom scam. In 1998, he formed the Himachal Vikas Congress (HVC) and entered into a post-poll alliance with the BJP and joined the government.

Sukh Ram contested the Assembly elections from Mandi Sadar in 1998 and won by a huge margin of votes. In the 2003 Assembly elections, he retained the Mandi seat but re-joined the Congress in the run-up to the 2004 Lok Sabha elections.

In 2017, just before the state Assembly elections, Sukh Ram, along with his son Anil Sharma, joined the BJP and campaigned for it extensively in Mandi district. The BJP won nine out of 10 seats. Notice to Chief Secy over staff crunch in schools

SIMLA, MAY 11
Expressing concern on the issue of lack of staff in the government schools of the state, the HP High Court today issued notice to the Chief Secretary and Principal Secretary (Education). While issuing notices the court directed the officers to file their replies within three weeks.

A division bench comprising Chief Justice Mohammad Rafiq and Justice Sandeep Sharma passed these orders in a petition taken up suo moto by the court as a public interest litigation on a letter addressed to the Chief Justice by one Pratap Singh Thakur of Baghad village, Karsog tehsil in Mandi district.

In the petition, it was alleged that more than 2,000 posts of Junior Office Assistant and Librarian are lying vacant in the government schools across the state and the Education Department is not filling the posts deliberately so that the children in government schools join private schools to pursue their studies.

He has further alleged that due to lack of library and librarian in government schools, children are lagging behind in competitive examinations. As such, children are leaving government schools and opting for private schools. The petitioner has sought the court to direct the state government to fill the vacant posts of librarians in the government schools on priority.

CBI names 12 NGO representatives in illegal issuance of FCRA licence case, 14 arrested

NEW DELHI: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has named representatives of at least 12 non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and institutions, including Omidyar Network that is supported by billionaire philanthropist and e-Bay founder Pierre Omidyar, over an alleged case of bribe-for-approval. The case also names six officials of Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA) division of the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), one National Informatics Centre (NIC) official, two hawkya operators and several middlemen.

THE CBI CASE ALSO NAMES 6 OFFICIALS OF FCRA DIVISION OF THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS. Following Tuesday's raids, 14 people, including six hawkya operators, were arrested and 14.2 crore was retrieved.

Khan and former officials in the division. Taranjit Kumar Bhatnagar, Alok Ranjan and Ghansharaj Anand are also named in the CBI FIR first information report (FIR) but was yet to be arrested, the agency said.

The NGOs were getting FCRA clearances through backdoor so that they could continue receiving funds from foreign donors despite not fulfilling the prescribed norms. They also generated fake invoices to justify their expenditure for the defined cause, the agency added.
