

Centre to buy moong at MSP Lapse? Sidhu, drugs suspect in same barrack

CHANDIGARH, MAY 21

The Centre has agreed to implement the Price Support Scheme (PSS) for procurement of moong in Punjab for the rabi season 2021-22.

According to a spokesperson for the Chief Minister's office, the Centre has written to the state, conveying its approval to implement the PSS for procurement of 4,585 MT of summer moong for Rabi season 2021-22 as per the PSS guidelines, 2018. The letter further stated that the date of procurement will be decided by the state government and the procurement period will remain 90 days from such date. The spokesperson said the Centre's communication revealed that the central nodal agency should verify the availability of scientific storage space according to PSS guidelines before commencement of procurement. "The state government will provide a revolving fund equivalent to at least 15 per cent of procurement cost of sanctioned quantity and ensure that the payment is made directly into the bank accounts of the farmers within three

days of procurement," the letter reads. Notably, the Punjab Government has already decided to provide the minimum support price (MSP) to the farmers for moong grown before paddy cultivation and sought support from Centre.

Summer moong is a crop of 65 days with an expected yield of about 5 quintal per acre. It may be recalled that the MSP of unpolished moong is Rs 7,275 per quintal but market prices are often higher. India imports a substantial quantity of moong every year for domestic consumption. —TNS

nexus, involving high-profile officers — many still in service. He was lodged in the same barrack as Sidhu on Friday, but shifted out "after queries". Dismissed CIA Inspector Inderjit Singh, from whose

residence illegal weapons and ingredients were recovered in 2017, was housed in the same barrack as Sidhu. Sources in the Jail Department confirmed even lower rung jail staffers were surprised

to see Sidhu housed in the same barrack as the inmate. "Already, Punjab jails have seen murders and Sidhu, because of his anti-drug stance, is on their hit list," said a source. Sidhu surrendered on Friday, a day after the SC awarded one-year rigorous imprisonment in a 1988 road rage case. Yesterday evening, Sidhu was locked in the barrack after completing his formalities around 7.30 pm.

A senior IPS official said keeping any Punjab-based inmate facing drugs charges or linked to "big fish" in the trial could pose a serious threat. Sidhu, as also SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia. A spokesperson on behalf of the Jails Department to The Tribune once the report reached them about dismissed cop Inderjit Singh sharing the barrack with Sidhu, the ordered him to be shifted out. "The jail staff have informed me Inderjit has been moved to another barrack. We will look into the lapse, if any," he added, claiming there was no security issue inside the jail.

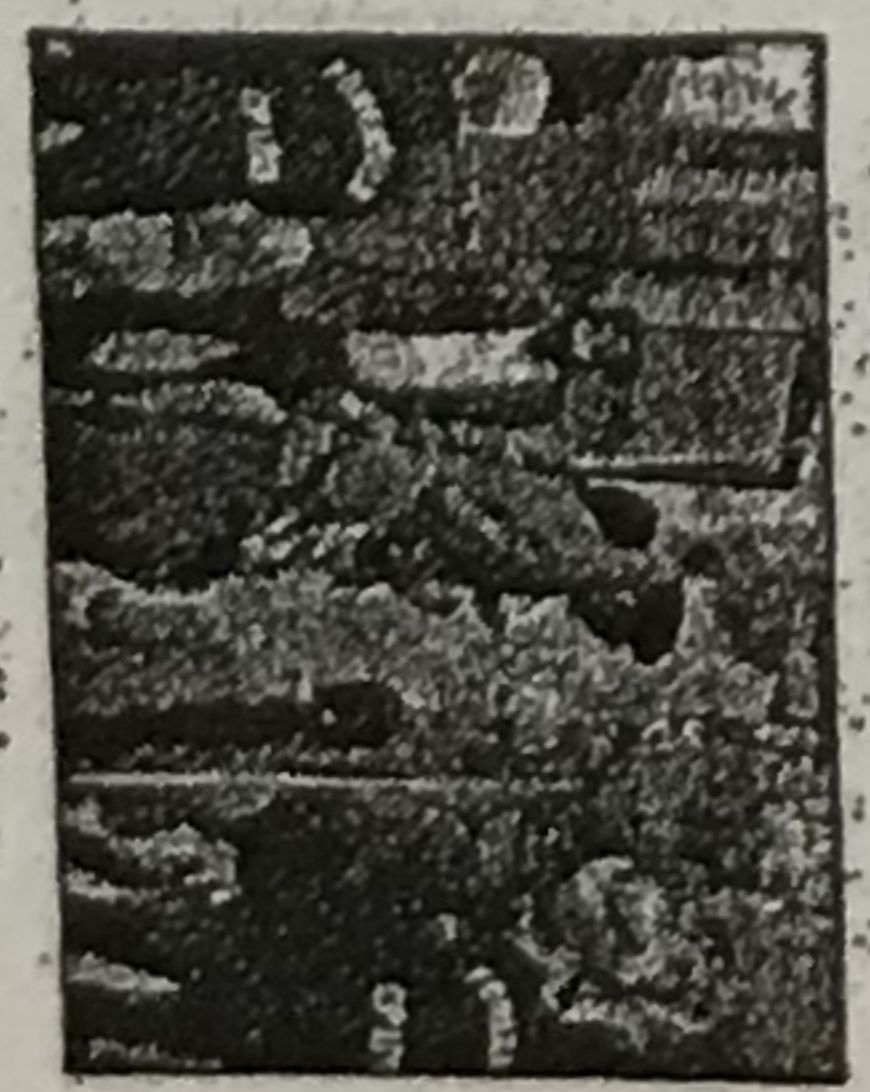

A total of six improvised explosive devices (IEDs) were smuggled by Pakistan-based separatist organisations and retrieved by Dilbagh Singh at the behest of Surmukh Singh, both of whom were nabbed by the Special Task Force (STF) yesterday in connection with the Ludhiana court blast case. This came to light during the interrogation of the two here today.
