Note: For Registration, each participant may fill in the google form by March 4, 2024, which are available on University website and Facebook page. On the Spot registrations will also be done on March 6, 2024 between 8:00-9:30 AM.

Participants Rules:

- 1. There is no restriction on the number of participants sent by each college/institution.
- 2. The entries/exhibits will be judged by a panel of judges and their decision will be final.
- 3. Each participant can register for more than one event/category.
- 4. Prizes will be given under each section of a category. However, if the number of entries for any section are 03 or less, only one prize will be given, if entries are 04 or 05, two prizes will be given and if the entries are more than 5, three

prizes will be given.

5. Depending on the number of entries, the number of prizes may be increased.
6. Participants may register individually or in group, but only one prize will be given.
7. For each competitive activity, the participants will bring the material, including vegetables, colours, drawing paper etc. themselves. The tables for display & cemented pots for painting will be provided by the organizers.
8. Potted plants will be judged based on number, size and quality of blooms and healthy foliage. Cut flowers will be judged based on size, quality and freshness.
9. All the potted plants must be brought to flower show ground early enough on the previous day and be placed in position by 6:00 PM on 05.03.2024
10. The cut flowers should be displayed in containers containing water only. The participants should bring their own vase.
11. The drawing should be made on chart paper with a minimum A4 size. Participants are advised to bring their own boards.
12. No exhibitor will be allowed in any section of the ground during judging.
13. The organizers will not be responsible for any

loss of any exhibits whether their plants, pots, vases, any other articles, etc.

14. The exhibitors will be allowed to remove their exhibits only after the function is over on 06.03.2024.
15. The organizers will appreciate it if exhibitors receive their prizes personally on 06.03.2024.

The assessment for the Best Garden and Nursery visit shall be on March 05, 2024.
