Handsome cash prizes may be given to the winner participants. In (Patriotic), Folk Song / Ragni, the participating colleges will be asked to send one student (Male /Female) to sing the glory of soldiers of Haryana / land of Haryana and other proud possession of the land and finally Harynavi Hasya Kavi Sammelan will be consisting of renowned Haryanvi Poets alongwith a parallel participation of students from various colleges who will perform the wits and satires of

The rules and regulations for the contest will be will be as under :-

Rules and Regulations

Quiz Contest

A College/Institution can send only one team comprising of three i) participants (Boys or Girls or both) ii)

The question asked will be of general knowledge having focus on Haryanvi Culture, Literature, Life Style, Geography and History etc.

The decision of the Quiz Master, Scorer and the Time Keeper will be iii)

In case of the number of participating teams are above ten, a written iv) test for qualifying to contest in final will be held. This will be a multiple choice questionnaire.

There will be three rounds in the contest :-V)

a) Pair Question Round:

Two questions will be asked to each team giving the time of 10 (ten) seconds for each question to answer.

Each correct answer replied in time will carry 5 (five) marks.

b) Buzzer Round:

The question asked is open to all the teams and the team desiring to answer will ring the buzzer first. This round carries negative marks for incorrect answer.

If answer is correct 5 (five) marks will be awarded. ii)

- If answer is wrong, 2 (two) marks will be deducted from the total of iii)
- If no team rings the buzzer up to 15 (fifteen) seconds, the question will IV) be cancelled.

c) Rapid Fire Round:

In this round questions will be asked rapidly in a time period of 3(three) minutes. Every right answer will carry 2 (two) marks. There is no negative marking in this round.

Patriotic Folk Song / Ragni

1. A College /Institute can send only one student (male / Female).

2. Time allotted is not less than 5 minutes and not more than 7 minutes, excluding the setting time.

3. Cinema songs and recorded tunes are not allowed.

4. Maximum number of accompanists for playing instruments will be two.

5. Judgement will be based mainly on the quality of singing and not on make-up, costumes and action of the team.

6. The content and theme of the song should be on the Soldiers of Haryana and their bravery tales.

It is, therefore, requested to circulate the letter among the students of your Department/College/Institution for participation and recommend the names of students for participation in the above said competitions as per rules. The names of participating students may be sent to the Dean Students' Welfare Office, MDU, Rohtak latest by 31.10.2018 for all the events. The spot entries may also be allowed. No TA/DA will be paid by this office for the above participation. Handsome prizes will be given to the winners.
