Haryana: Hooda (junior), two others file nominations for RS

Congress nominee and former chief minister Bhupinder Singh Hooda's son, Deepender Singh Hooda, and two nominees of the Bharatiya Janata Party—Ram Chander Jangra and Dushyant Kumar Gautam on Friday filed their nomination for the Rajya Sabha elections from Haryana. All of them are set to enter the Upper House of Parliament unopposed as it was the last day for filing nomination for the three vacant Rajya Sabha seats in the state. The last date for withdrawal of

nomination is 18 March. A three-time Lok Sabha member from Rohtak, Deepender, narrowly lost to BJP's Arvind Sharma in 2019 general elections as the saffron party won all 10 parliamentary seats from the state. While Jangra is a backward class leader of the BJP, Gautam is party's vice-president. While two Rajya Sabha seats fell vacant due to resignation of BJP's Ram Kumar Kashyap and the expiry of Congress leader Kumari Selja's term next month, Jangra and Deepender entered the race to fill these vacancies to complete a full term.

A third vacancy which entailed a bypoll arose following the resignation of former Union minister and BJP leader Birender Singh, Gautam is set to enter the Upper House for the remaining term. In the 90-member Haryana Assembly, the BJP has 40 MLAs while its alliance partner JJP has 10. The main opposition Congress has 31 members while six out of seven independent MLAs have extended support to the BJP-JJP coalition government. The INLD has one MLA while one member belongs to the Haryana Lokhit.

Kalita, Dalmary may return to RS from Assam

Veteran politician and a Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) nominee Bhubaneswar Kalita along with Bodoland People's Front (BPF) candidate Biswajit Daimary is expected to return to Rajya Sabha from Assam with the scheduled polls on 26 March.

However, senior journalist and a human rights activist Ajit Kumar Bhuyan, supported by the Opposition Congress and All India United Democratic Front (AIUDE) still faces uncertainty in sailing for the third seat from the state. A senior Congress leader shifted to the saffron brigade. Kalita resigned from RS last year to join the BJP on eve of enacting the Citizenship Amendment Bill amidst massive outrages in the Brahmaputra valley of Assam. The ruling party has announced Kalita as its first candidate for the RS polls. BJP's political ally BPF announced the current RS member Daimary for the second seat. The state legislative assembly at present has 124 members, where the BJP has 60 legislators.
