<u>District Magistrate-Cum- Chairman, DDMA, Rohtak</u> ORDER

Whereathe Disaster Management Authority Haryana Chandigarh has issued revised SOPs for social academic/sports/ entertainment/religious/functions and other congregation vide memo No, DMC-SPO-2020/8065 dated 03.12.2020(copy enclosed alongwith enclosures) with reference to Order DMC-SPO-2020/7053 dated 22.10.2020, as under:-

- i. In six district namely Gurugram, Faridabad, Rohtak, Hisar, Sonipat and Rewari in closed spaces, a maximum of 50% persons (i.e.50persons in the hall capacity of 100). In rest of the districts, a maximum of 50% of the hall capacity will be allowed, with a ceiling of 100 persons (i.e. 100 persons in the hall capacity of 200). Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision for thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer with be mandatory.
- ii. In open spaces in six districts namely Gurugram, Faridabad, Rohtak, Hisar, Sonipat and Rewari gathering will be allowed with the ceiling of 100 persons and rest of districts, the ceiling will be 200 persons with strict observance of social distancing, mandatory wearing of face masks, provision for thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer.

And whereas it has been further directed that the organizers of social, academic/sports/entertainment/ cultural/religious political functions and other congregation shall take prior permission of District Magistrates, The District Magistrates will issue permissions after seeking necessary NOCs from the concerned departments including Police.

And whereas all the provisions of the SOPs issued vide letter dated 06.10.2020 by the ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India on preventive measures to contain speared of COVID-19 during festivities (Annexure-A) shall also be followed in letter & spirit.

Now, therefore, I, Capt. Manoj Kumar, IAS, District Magistrate-Cum-Chairman, DDMA, Rohtak in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 30 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 direct all the concerned officers/officials in the district of Rohtak, to strictly comply with the above instructions, meticulously, issued by the State Government.

The following joint inspection teams for enforcing the above instructions/directions to ensure extensive checking and action against the violators as per law/rule/instructions/directions issued from time to time by the State Government of Haryana.

Any person violating this order will invite immediate penal action under Section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005 besides legal action U/S 188 of the IPC, 1860, as per National Directives and the offences and penalties for violating measures as enclosed with the above letter {MHA Order dated 30 Sep. 2020 (Annexure-B)} in the form of Annexure I & II.

It is also clarified that the directions of Ministry of Home Affairs(MHA), Government of India regarding guidelines for re-opening issued dated 30 Sep. 2020 and consequent SOPs released by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MOHFW), Government of India dated 06th Oct. 2020 shall not be diluted in any manner, whatsoever, while complying with these Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)

These standard Operating Procures (SOPs) shall come into force with immediate effect.

The order shall be promulgated in the area of district Rohtak by affixing copies of this order on the Notice Boards of District, Sub Divisional, Tehsil Offices, other Public Places, by beat of drum, announcement through the publicity van of Information a& Public Relations Department, publications in the newspapers having circulation in the area through the office of the DIPRO, Rohtak and publicity may also be carried out through social media.

ADIO, NIC, Rohtak is directed to host this order on the official website of district Rohtak.

In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and is addressed the Public at large
