MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY FOR PROVIDING ACCOMMODATION & OTHER FACILITIES AND TO SUGGEST THE MECHANISM TO EXTEND HELP TO AFGHAN STUDENTS IN THE PREVAILING EMERGENT SITUATION AT AFGHANISTAN HELD ON 19.08.2021 AT 12:00 NOON IN THE OFFICE OF DEAN, CIAA

The Committee considered the request of Afghan students for provision of accommodation and mess facility (Flag-'A') in wake of the prevailing emergent situation in Afghanistan and made following observations/recommendations:

Observations:

Recommendations:

1. Among the 41 Afghan students admitted in various 2 year PG programs of UTDs, only two students are residing in Rohtak and their VISA has been extended till 30.09.2021 in light of extension of academic session due to COVID-19 pandemic. For these students, accommodation and mess facility may be provided on credit basis based on their request till September 30th, 2021 and after that period their case may be decided as per Government direction. An undertaking to this effect may be taken from such students (America I)

2. Afghan students pursuing their education in 5 year integrated programs (AY 2019-20) and 2 year PG programs (admitted in AY 2020-2021) may be allowed to continue their education with a provision of accommodation & mess on credit basis i.e. not asking them to deposit the requisite fee/charges presently, however they are required to pay such fee/charges as soon as the situation becomes normal. An undertaking to this effect may be taken from such students.

3. The financial assistance to the Afghan students who will continue their education in the next academic session may also be given through the schemes (Sahyog Scheme/Earn by learn) of DSW, M. D. University, Rohtak based on their request through the respective HODS/ Directors.

4. The Chief Warden (Boys) must ensure the accommodation of Afghan students in International Students' Hostel and provide mess facility on diet basis and credit basis.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE CONSITITUTED BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR HELD ON 29.10.2021 AT 1:00 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF DEAN, ACADEMIC AFFIARS TO CONSIDER THE REQUESTS/GRIEVANCES OF VARIOUS STUDENTS.

The Committee deliberated upon the issues involved in the applications of the students for admissions refereed to Grievance Redressal Committee by the university authorities and resolved as under:

- 1. The committee considered the request of Ms Rekha Rani for not submitting the fee of M.Sc. Biochemistry 3rd semester as well the request of other students of IHTM, IMSAR and MDU-CPAS alongwith the note of Director, IMSAR stating that candidates admitted through physical counselling on 26.10.2021 could not pay fee due to problem in payment gateway. In view of the comments of Director UCC that there was a problem in the Payment Gateway, the committee resolved that the date be extended upto 10th November 2021 for submitting the fee online by students of intermediate semesters of UTDS and MDU-CPAS, Gurugram in view of the holidays falling in 1st week of November, 2021.
- 2. The Committee considered the request of Afghan Students for nonsubmission of the Admission fee for the 5th semester of M.Com. Program due to the situation prevailing in Afghanistan. In this regard, the committee considered the "minutes of meeting of the committee constituted to explore the possibility for providing accommodation and other facilities and to suggest the mechanism to extend help to Afghan students in the prevailing Emergent Situation at Afghanistan held on 19-08-2021', duly approved by Vice-Chancellor, provided by the office of Centre for International Academic Affairs (Copy as Annexure A). The committee considered the relevant recommendation of minutes ie. Resolution no.2. of minutes which is reproduced as under

"Afghan students pursuing their education in 5 year programs (AY 2019- 20) and 2 year PG programs (admitted in AY 2020-2021) may be allowed to continue their education with a provision of accommodation & mess on credit basis i.e. not asking them to deposit the requisite fee/charges presently, however they are required to pay such fee/charges as soon as the situation becomes normal. An undertaking to this effect may be taken from such students".

Based on the above recommendation, the committee resolved that the Afghan Students be directed to pay a fee of Rs.1000/- as token amount for admission to the concerned semester of various programs to facilitate admission and CR (Continuation of Registration) process. Further, the committee also resolved that an undertaking be taken from the Afghan students that they will pay remaining admission fee before the starting of end semester examination i.e. 30-01-2022.

- 3. The committee considered the request of Mr. Saurabh, Student of Bachelor of Hotel Management of IHTM for extension in date for fee submission. Considering the number of holidays falling in between the last date of deposition of admission fee, the committee resolved that date be extended upto 10th November 2021 for submitting the fee online by the student.
- 4. The committee considered the request of Mr. Puneet Sharma for considering the admission in M.Com. Program against supernumerary seat and resolved that the comments of HOD commerce be sought in the matter.
