1. Finalization of the list of equipments to be purchased (in continuation with the meeting held on 19-7-2017).

2. Any other matter.

(i) Purchase of Portable Photosynthesis (IRGA):

The Chairman presented a request from Dr. S.S. Gill (CBT), for reconsidering the purchase of "Portable Photosynthesis (IRGA)", under CIL, in 2017-18. The Chairman apprised the Advisory Committee that this request had been duly received and considered in the meeting of the Advisory

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Committee held on 19-7-2017, and this item had not been then shortlisted for purchase, on the basis of "lack of multiple users". Now, in the present request, Dr. Gill has again requested to consider the purchase of this item, and underlined the multiple user potential of the instrument. The Advisory Committee perused the fresh request by Dr. Gill for purchase of this item, and upon deliberations, recommended that this item may also be included in the list of items to be purchased in 2017-18.
