MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE HELD ON 26.09.2019 AT 3.00 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF DEAN ACADEMIC AFFAIRS, M.D.UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO CONSIDERED GRIEVANCE OF STUDENFS OF IN RESPECT OF ADMISSION AND INCREASE OF SEATS IN ADVANCED P.G. DIPLOMA COURSE IN PSYCHOLOGY

Various issues related to admissions were discussed in detail and the Committee unanimously recommended as under:-:

 The committee considered the recommendations of Departmental Committee of the Department of psychology and recommended that 20 seats in Advanced Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling be increased for session 2019-20 only.

The Committee further resolved that the counselling for the above increased seats be conducted by the Department on 30.09.2019 and the candidates be asked to deposit the fee on the same day. The admissions be made from the merit list already available with the Department and as per reservation policy strictly on the basis of merit and other rules as mentioned in the prospectus. For this purpose all the candidates be informed through SMS or telephonically by the Department as the time left is very short. Notice be also displayed on the University website as well as on the notice board of the Department. After the above stipulated date no admissions will be made in any case if the seat remain vacant.

2. Considered the request of a girl student Ms. Nidhi who wants to take admission in Advanced P.G. Diploma in Guidance and Counselling against single girl child supernumerary seats but she did not apply against these supernumerary seats.

Committee resolved that the request of the candidate cannot be acceded to this stage as per rules. However, she may appear for the counselling on 30.09.2019 for seeking admission to the programme.

 Considered the request dated 20.09.2019 submitted by Ms. Seema for the admission to LLM (evening shift) in the Department of Law who wants to seek admission in LLM (evening shift) for which the counselling was fixed by the Department on 31.08.2019 but she could not admitted due to non-submission of gap year affidavit. The Committee perused the letter dated 25.07.2017 received from the DHE Haryana regarding condition of gap year and resolved that the request of the candidate for admission to the course be acceded to as the candidate having lower merit has already been admitted by the Department on 31.08.2019. For this purpose, an additional seat be created in anticipation of approval of Admission Committee as a special case. The candidate be asked telephonically by the Department to appear with all documents and requisite fee in the Department on 30.09.2019.

4. Considered the matter with regard to fill up the two vacant seats in the Department of Environmental Sciences and six seats in the Department of Sanskrit.

The Committee reiterate its earlier stand as taken in its meeting held on 14.09.2019 that no fresh admissions be made in the Departments/Colleges after 31.08.2019 as per instructions of the State Government even if seats remain vacant.

5. The Committee perused the note dated 19.09.2019 received from the Head and Dean, Faculty of Law with regard to following latest position of admissions in various certificate and Diploma courses for the session 2019-20 and recommended as under:

In view of the above, the Committee found that it is not viable to run the course under SFS with a very low strength. Hence, the Committee recommended that the Certificate Courses be merged with Diploma Courses and the Students who have already taken admissions in Certificate Courses be asked to switch over to Diploma Course. For this purpose, option may be taken from the admitted students. If the students are not willing to switch over to the Diploma Courses, their fee may be refunded.

6. The Committee considered the request dated 26.09.2019 of a Foreign student namely, Abdullah Addulameer Salman for admission to LLM programme in the Department of Law.

In the meeting, the Dean, Faculty of Law informed that 50 to 60% papers of the Degree of Bachelor of Rights passed by the candidate from University of Tikit (Iraq) are similar to LLB course of this University. Since, the candidate has already been given offer letter for admission to LLM programme on the basis of recommendations of the Law Department, to avoid hardship to the Foreign student, the Committee recommended that the Degree of Bachelor of Rights from University of Tikit (Iraq) be considered as equivalent to Bachelor of Law Degree of this University for the purpose of admission to LLM programme.

The committee further resolved that in future before giving offer letters for admissions to the Foreign candidates, the matter with regard to equivalency of Foreign Degrees be got decided through the Committee already constituted by the Academic Council for the purpose where no specific recommendations are received from AIU, New Delhi.
