RULES REGARDING QUIZ COMPETITION

held on 21.03.2020, Department of Law, MDU Rohtak

ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION:

- 1. Participation of teams will be determined on the basis of their scores in screening test (Written).
- 2. Screening Test will be held in the Law Department at sharp 09:00 am. If the teams will be more than six.
- 3. The organizing committee will have the sole and absolute discretion to short list the teams on the basis of performance in screening test (Written).
- 4. Each team for the Law Quiz shall comprise of two students. The teachers will be allowed to accompany their teams.
- 5. Quiz contest will be held among six short listed teams on the basis of their screening test performance.
- 6. Decision of Quiz Master relating to any query shall be final.
- 7. If there will be any issue regarding the rules, the organizing committee's decision shall be final
- 8. The organizers reserve the right to vary, alter, modify or repeal any of the aforesaid rules if so required or feel appropriate.
- 9. The teams seeking participation or participating in the competition shall be expected to honor and respect the spirit of the competition and endeavour good conduct by themselves accordingly.
- 10. In case of any issue if raised during the course of the competition, the organizing committee shall have the sole and absolute authority to resolve the issues.
- 11. No questions shall be raised against the selection process of teams.
- 12. The certificate of participation shall be given to all the participants.
- 13. Each team need to produce the bonafide certificate alongwith attested photo issued by the competent authority of their institutions.
- 14. Result of the screening test will be declared immediately after the test.
- 15. The screening test will be MCQ based related to general knowledge.
- 16. The competition shall be conducted strictly in English language only.
- 17. There will be nine rounds in the competition.
 - (i) The reply given by the first participant of the team will only be considered.

- (ii) The teams will be given fifteen second to answer of all the rounds except the rapid fire round.
- (iii) First two rounds will be plain round and no question forwarded to another team.
- (iv) Third and fourth rounds will be buzzer rounds.
- (v) Further, Fifth and Six rounds will be carry forward rounds.
- (vi) After that Seventh and Eighth rounds will be carry forward round alongwith bonus round.
- (vii) Ninth round will be final round as a rapid fire. In rapid fire round teams have to answer ten questions within three minutes.
- 18. The teams shall not be allowed to use book/electronic gazettes during the competition.
- 19. In case of tie in buzzer round decision of Quiz Master shall be final.
- 20. The organizer reserve the absolute right to cancel, defer or postpone the competition in case of any incident happened natural or manmade.
- 21. Jury shall be comprised of three eminent experts.
- 22. The decision of Jury shall be final and binding on all concerned questions/issues raised during the Quiz Contest.

GENERAL RULES

- All participants are expected to maintain the decorum throughout the competition.
- The organizers reserve the right to take appropriate action for any unethical, unprofessional or immoral conduct of the team participants.
- Participants should be in decent dress.
