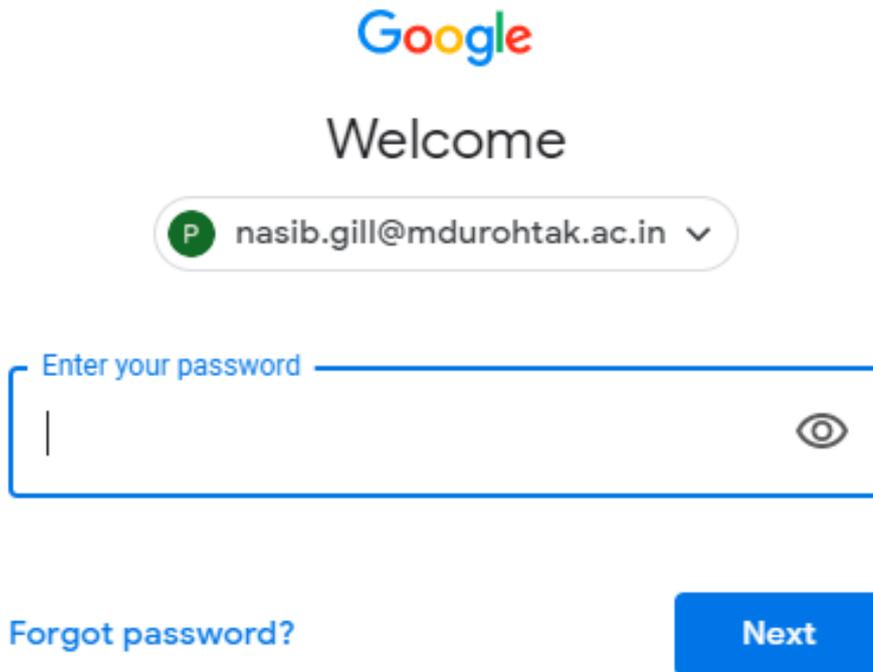
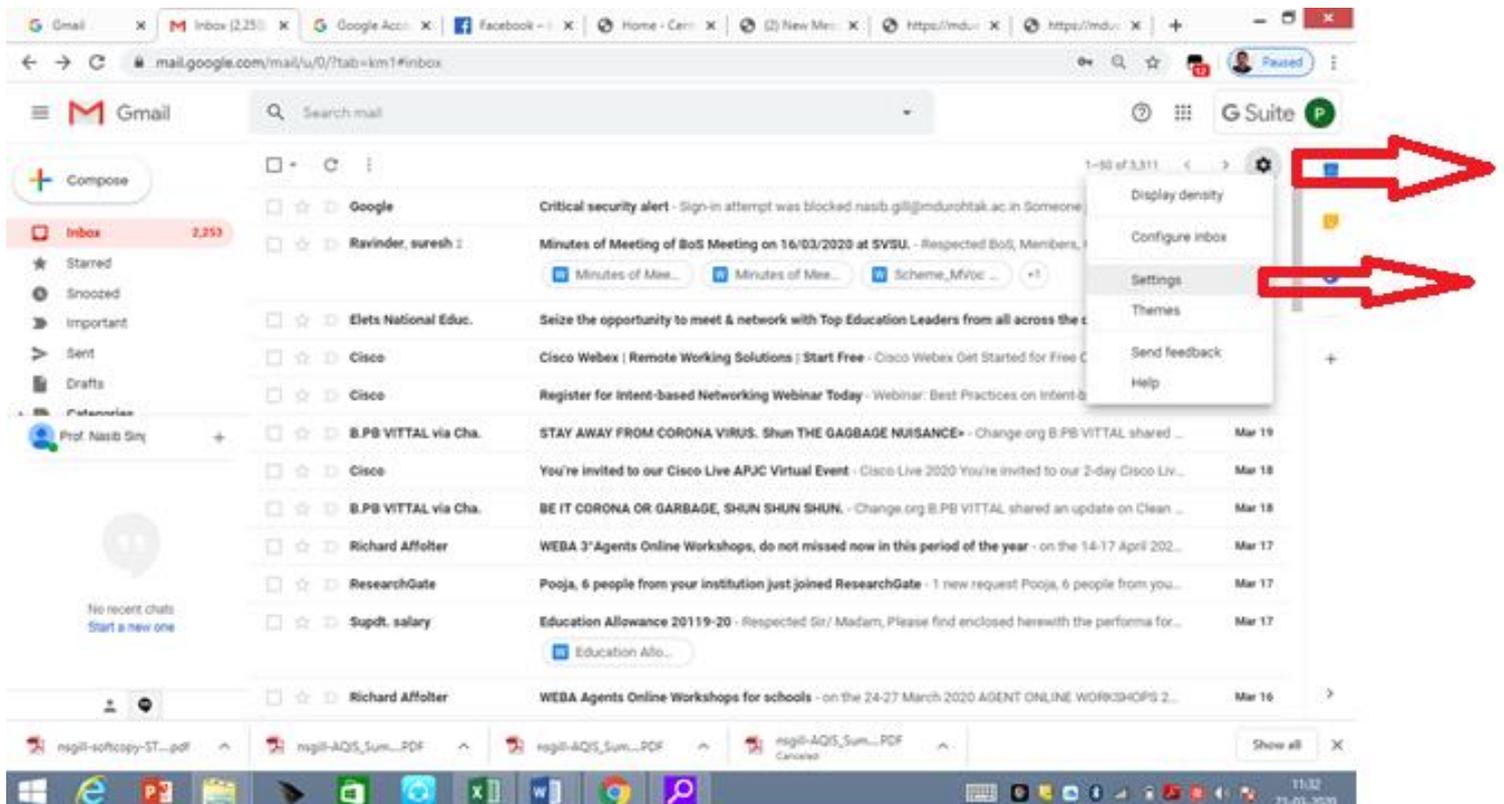


You are 8-steps away from Off Campus Remote Access of MDU Library E-resources

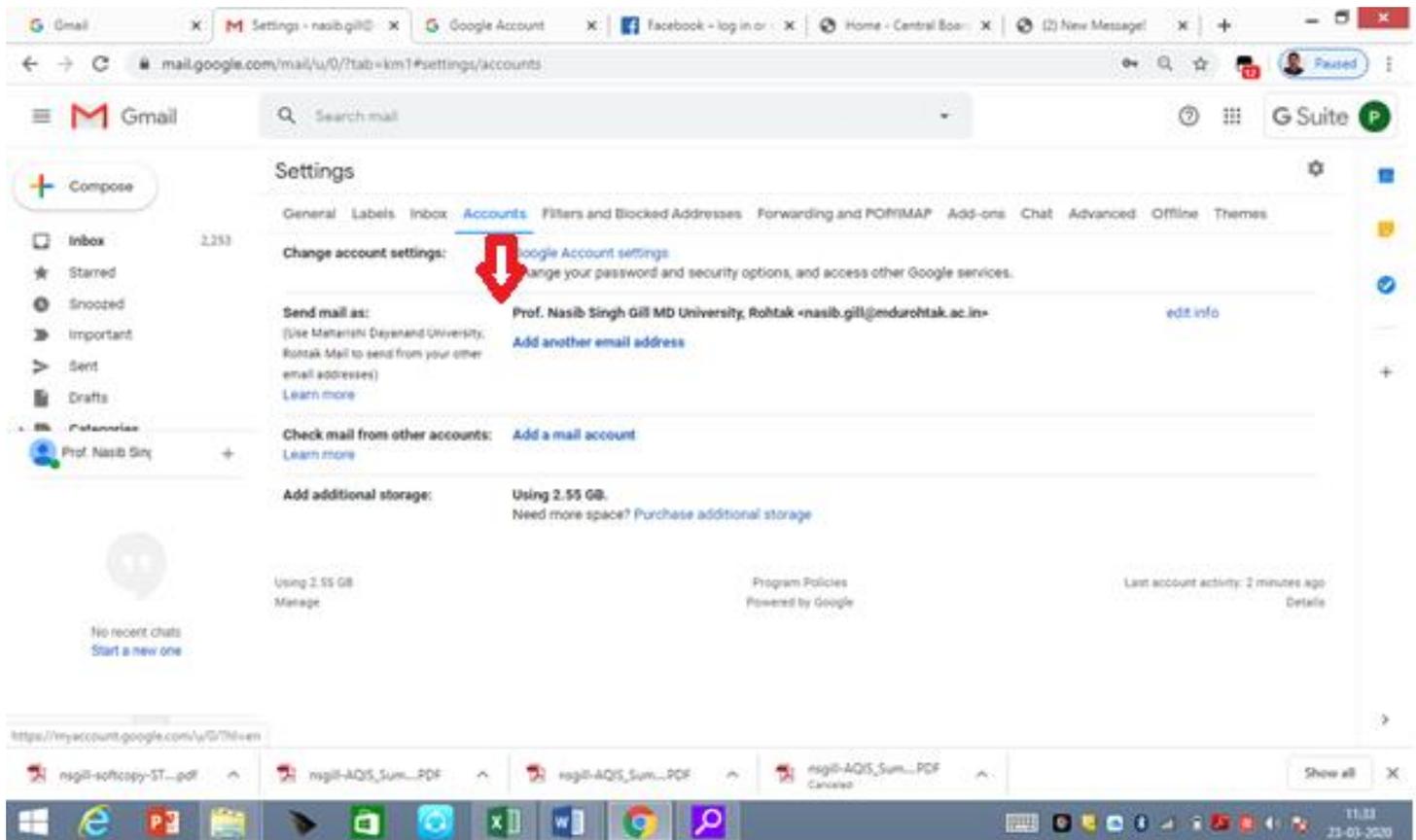
Step 1: Login in your MDU domain email account (as pointed by red arrow) and sign in



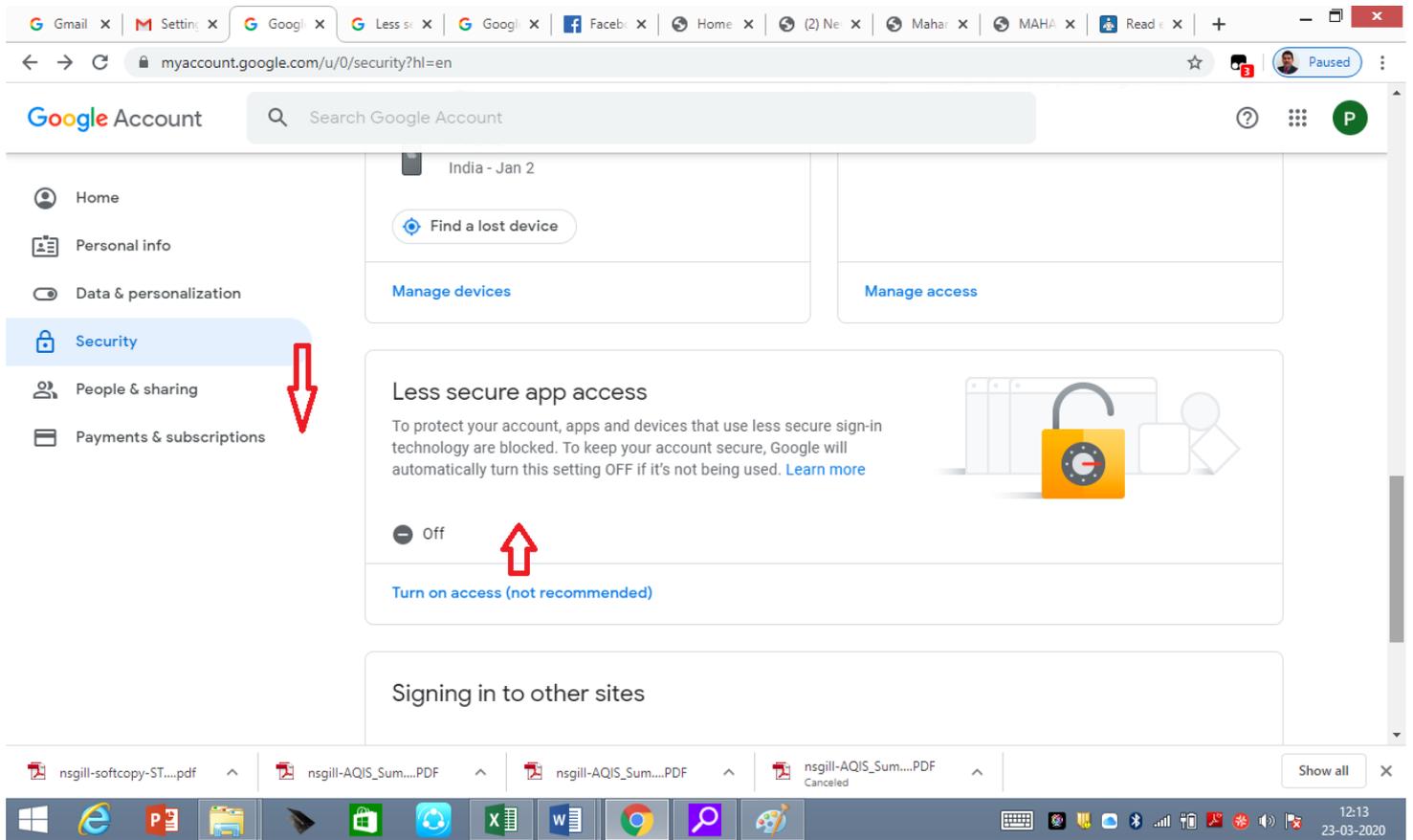
Step 2: On left panel under Setting icon click Settings option (see red Arrows).



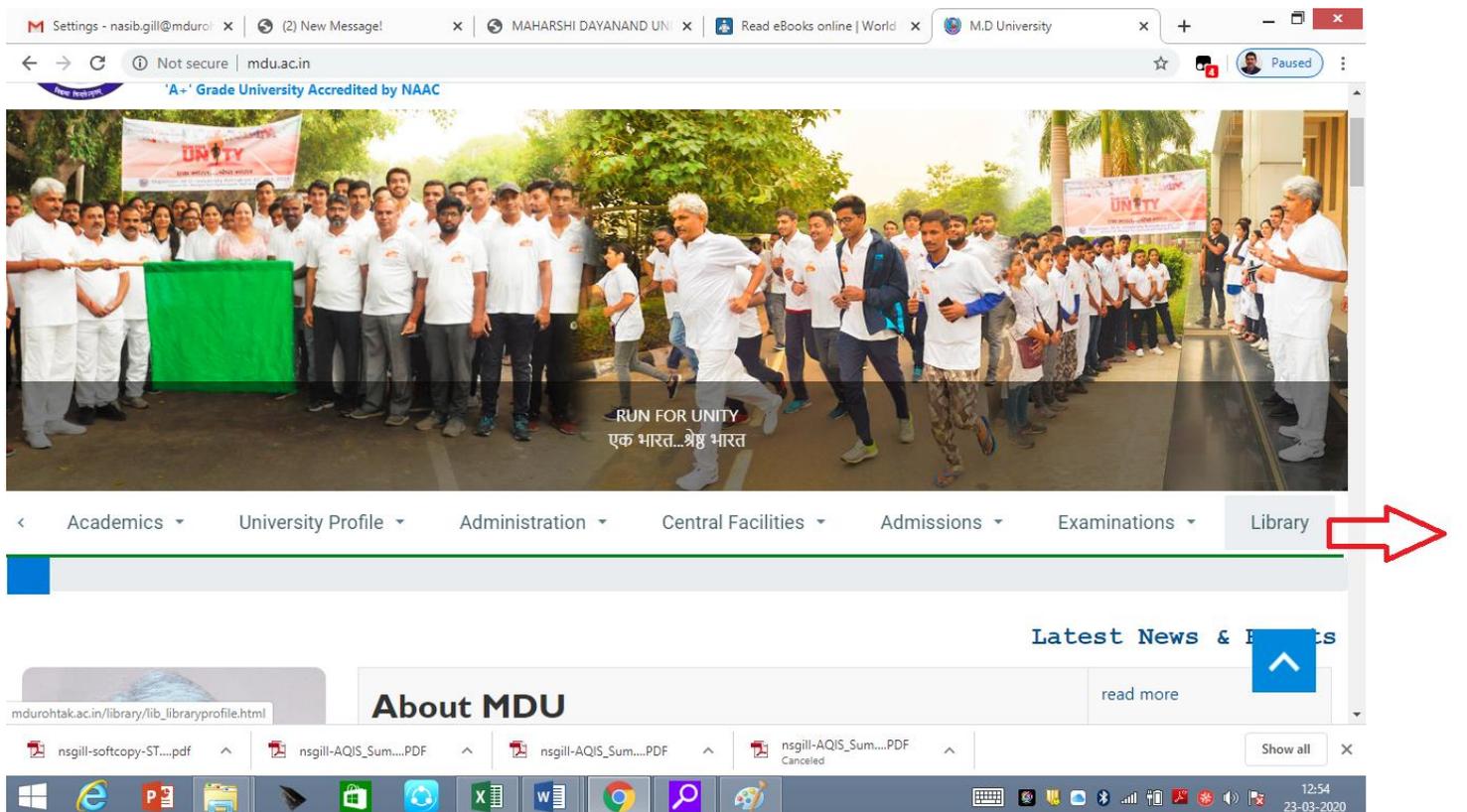
Step 3: On top bar select Accounts option and then Click Google Account Settings (as pointed by red arrows).



Step 4: Now on the left panel click 4th option Security (as pointed by red arrow) and then scroll down until you see Less secure app access (which is off) as shown and now click the blue link (to turn it On). If it is on then you will be able to access MDU Library resources through Remote Access.



Step 5: Visit MDU website www.mdu.ac.in and then click Library as shown by red arrow.



Step-6: Now as shown in top bar of the following window under Digital Library follow Remote Access as pointed out by Red Arrow.
