

ADMISSION IN GIRLS HOSTELS

Please read the Hostel HBI carefully before applying for admissions. ALLOTMENT:

- a) All rights of admission to the University Girls Hostels are reserved with the Chief Warden (Girls)
- b) Rooms will be allotted by the Warden, counter signed by the Deputy Chief Warden and Warden of the respective Hostel.
- c) All residents should be vaccinated at the time of taking admission and are expected to follow all COVID-19 appropriate behaviour and other guidelines issued by State Government and University Authorities from time to time.
- c) Three (3) seats are reserved for foreign students in each hostel and 20% seats are reserved for SC/ST students in each hostel as per state government reservation policy w.e.f. 2020-21.
- d) Fresh/Junior students shall be put in the dormitories.
- e) No student would be admitted in the hostel without the recommendation of the HOD. All the applications must reach the Office of the concerned Hostel Warden, within the stipulated time.
- f) Resident cannot shift from her allotted room without the permission of the Warden/Chief Warden.
- g) In case the possession of the room is not taken by the applicant within a period of 15 days, her admission will be cancelled and fee will not be refunded.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND SUBMISSION OF ADMISSION FORMS

- Application for admissions in the hostel will be given only to those female students whose residence is more than 30 kms from the University.
- Only fully vaccinated students will be allowed to apply for accommodation in hostels.
 Further, no hostel will be allowed to that student who is in a gainful employment, i.e.
 holding any appointment paid or otherwise or recieve any emoluments, salary, etc.
 from any source. Students pursuing Diploma/Certificate and second UG/PG programs
 will also be not allowed hostel accommodation.
- Admission forms are available *Online* on the University Website and by *Offline Mode* from the office of the concerned Wardens. Online "Hostel Admission Form" fee (Rs. 80/-) can be deposited by going to University Website, www.mdu.ac.in, first and then pay through the link "Pay fee online through SB Collect".
- HOD/Director of respective departments will forward the lists of students along with hostel forms strictly on the basis of academic merit of only those students who reside beyond 30 kms from the University. The distance will be measured from the residential address city/village as mentioned in the admission form and on the basis of residential proof.
- Each admitted students has to *bring her* parents, mother and/or father, along with their Aadhar Card and two recent family photographs in the concerned department. However, if mother / or father are not alive, their death certificate must be attached. In this case the applicant can *bring* her sister/guardian along with her Aadhar Card and two recent collective photographs endorsed by the HOD of the respective department in which she has taken the admission.
- All columns have to be filled with correct information, for which the applicant is responsible.
- Each admitted student has to attach/upload residential proof in the form of viz. Aadhar Card, Voter Card, Driving Licence, Ration Card etc. This is mandatory.

- Each admitted student has to attach/upload the undertaking against Ragging.
- Each admitted student has to attach/upload all undertakings regarding hostel rules.
- Each admitted student should bring six latest photographs of passport size.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE FOR HOSTELS RESIDENTS:

- 1. 24 hours Security guards are available on the main gate of the MDU girls hostel campus along with lady security within the girls hostel complex.
- 2. CCTV cameras are installed at the entrance of main gate as well as in the entrance of each MDU girls' hostel separately.
- 3. Ambulance facility is provided in the MDU girls' hostel for the medical services.
- 4. Medical health camps are organised time to time by the Red Cross Society for the routine investigation like blood profile, urine test, eyes and dental tests etc.
- 5. MATURAM Yajanshala adjacent to the MDU girls' hostel campus where hawans are performed on every Thursday from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm in summer and 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm in winter for moral discourses and mental peace.
- 6. Sound system in each hostel is available for the announcement of necessary information to the residents.
- 7. Cooperative Mess facility is provided in each MDU Girls' hostel.
- 8. Well furnished MESS, COMMON ROOM with LCD facility, READING ROOM with magazine and newspaper are available in each hostel.
- 9. Water coolers with water purifier are available in every hostel.
- 10. Geyser facilities are available in every girls' hostel.
- 11. Green and clean environment is maintained in the MDU girls' hostel premises.
- 12. Hostel provides a bed, a table and a chair separately for each resident.
- 13. Sanitary Napkins Vending machines are available in the Girls Hostels.
- 14. The directions received from Govt. of Haryana regarding "No Mask, No Services" will be strictly adhered by all.

Grievance Redressal

- * There is an RTI Cell for each hostel and Ms. Sunita Malhan is PIO and Mrs. Anju is the APIO. Each Warden is required to reddress the grievances of the residents within 72 hours failing which the matter be reported to the Chief Warden. If the Chief Warden fails to solve the problem within a week, it would be reported to the Proctor and if still remain unresolved the same may be reported to the Vice-Chanellor.
- * The residents are required to observe the above hierarchical order while reporting their complaints/problems and in no case they should violate it, otherwise serious action will be taken against them.

GENERAL RULES FOR HOSTELLERS

DO'S

- Admissions shall be sought afresh in every academic session and the residents will conform to the following:
 - a) *Hard copy* duly signed by the parents/guardian of the resident and recommended by the HOD/Director of the respective Deptt./Institute/Centre etc. has to be submitted to the hostel.

- b) The candidates selected for admission in the hostels are required to submit an undertaking that they will not handover their rooms to anybody else and vacate the hostel room within 48 hours after the completion of theory examinations/practical examination. In case of Ph.D students, the research scholars shall have to vacate the room in the hostel within 48 hours after the date of their viva-voce examination. The research scholars who have submitted their Ph.D thesis shall not be considered for fresh admission in the hostel.
- c) The Ph. D students are eligible to get admissions in University Girls Hostels who have been availing scholarship/fellowship from any recognized funding government institutions. HODs/Directors are required to recommend the cases of only those Ph. D scholars whose attendance in the Department/Institute is compulsory. Research scholars have also to fill an additional form Annexure-A which is available in the office of hostel Warden for their admissions in the university hostel alongwith the following documents: detail of attendance register, detail of fellowship, Aadhar Card, Registration Proof. However, she has to vacate the hostel during summer vacation for repair, white washing and other works of maintenance.
- d) Day Scholars, bus pass holders, evening students *except LLM (evening)*, students of correspondence courses/diploma/certificate/2nd P.G./2nd M.Phil college students and casual students are not eligible for admission in the hostels.
- e) The students whose parents are residing within the distance of **30 kms.** from Rohtak are not entitled for the hostel admissions. If any student gives wrong address in the form she will be expelled from the hostel/University.
- e) Before leaving the hostel, every resident shall obtain clearance from the Hostel Supervisor/ Warden and personally hand over the charge of the room and hostel property to the Hostel Supervisor. A penalty of Rs. 500/- will be imposed on the defaulter.
- f) The residents are required to keep the hostel Identity Card (issued by Warden Office) with them all the time otherwise they will be treated as outsiders.
- g) Satisfaction of the Chief Warden/Wardens regarding proper conduct and regular payment of dues of hostel, mess and canteen in case of ex-residents.

DONT'S

The hostel resident will not indulge in the following:-

- i) No damage to the hostel property.
- ii) Mutual shifting of rooms is not allowed without the permission of Warden/Chief Warden.
- iii) Residents shall be in their rooms during night time and will not move to other rooms for sleeping without the permission of the Warden.
- iv) Ragging is strictly prohibited. In case of violation, expulsion from the hostel as well as legal case may be filed against the accused.
- v) Smoking is strictly prohibited. In case anyone found a fine of **Rs. 500/-** will be imposed.
 - a. In case of repeated violation *Rs. 1000/-* and expulsion from the hostel.
- vi) Use of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Any violator is to be fined Rs. 5000/- and expulsion from the hostel.
- vii) Drug abuse will be treated as a crime and invites a fine of Rs. 5000/- and expulsion from the hostel.
- viii) Indulgence in political activities and holding of demonstration in the hostel-premises is not allowed. Strict disciplinary action including cancellation of admission in hostel as well as in the department would be taken for violation.

- ix) Residents are not allowed to use more than one LED/CFL tube/bulb. They must switch off the light while going out of the room or to sleep, failing which a fine of *Rs. 100/-* will be imposed.
- x) A resident is not allowed to use in her room electrical appliances such as electric heaters, rods etc. In case a resident is found in possession of any electric appliances without permission, the appliances will be confiscated and she will be fined up to a minimum of Rs. 500/- per appliance. In case a resident repeats such act, the amount of fine payable will also increase accordingly.
- xi) A fine of Rs. 500/- will be charged, if any resident is found using cooler/Iron without prior permission and necessary payment.
- xii) Four wheelers in hostel-premises will not be permitted, however, two wheelers can be used by the hostellers. The University will not responsible for any theft of vehicle.
- xiii) No outsider is allowed to enter the hostel without the permission of Warden concerned.

THE RESIDENT WILL BE BARRED FROM APPLYING FOR HOSTEL ADMISSION IN CASE OF:-

- (i) If she sublets the allotted room to any other student/outsider.
- (ii) If some other student is found staying in her place in the allotted room without permission.
- (iii) Any damage of property of hostel, the estimated amount will be recovered from the persons /residents involved in the incident.
- (iv) Any clash, assault on co-resident will be seriously dealt in terms of rustication from the University apart from the legal action against such residents.
- (v) Any violation of the hostel rules the admission of the resident from the hostel will be cancelled.
- (vi) No outsider is allowed to enter the hostel without the permission of Warden concerned.
- (vii) If any outsider/unauthorized person are found in the resident's room, the resident shall be liable to (a) expulsion from the hostel with information to parents (b) forfeiture of security and/or (c) a fine of Rs. 2000.
- (viii) If any resident is found violating any directions and orders of the University repeatedly or on grounds of miscunduct during her stay in the hostels she may be expelled/denied hostel accommodation.
- (ix) Indulgence in political activities, anti-National activities, holding of demonstration, pasting of posters in and outside the hostel premises, defacement of walls and involvement in undesirable activities such as misbehavior/ physical assault with Hostel Warden/Supervisor/ Mess Supervisor /Mess Staff/ Housekeeping staff/ Security Guard or any other officer/official of the University.

OTHER HOSTEL RULES

- i) The residence will have to abide by all COVID-19 appropriate behaviour and other related advisory/ guidelines issued by MHA/ UGC/State Government/ MD University from time to time and submit all undertakings when ever required.
- ii) All Residents are required to carry hard copy of Hostel Identity Card with them all time because security man of the Girls Hostels will check any time at the entry of the main gate.
- iii) No residents will be allowed for night stay in other hostel.
- iv) Residents are not allowed to move the items of furniture from their allotted rooms.
- v) All residents have to use Common Rooms and other facilities like T.V., news papers, magazines, sports items, etc. in proper way. The residents shall be fully responsible for any damage/loss of hostel property. Repair charges for any damage to any item of hostel property shall have to be paid by the resident.

- vi) Residents should be properly dressed while going to the Common Room, Dinning Room, Study Room and Hostel Office.
- vii) Residents should not keep cash or jewellary or other valuable items in their rooms. The responsibility of safety of the belongings will be entirely that of the residents.
- viii) The hostel authorities will not be responsible for such type of acts in which the resident tries to harm herself purposely.
- ix) Residents who wish to keep their own vehicle, must take permission and get the vehicle pass issued from the concerned hostel Warden.
- x) Residents are required to maintain proper hygienic conditions in washrooms as well as their personal rooms. Dustbin should be used appropriately.
- xi) A fine of Rs. 500/- will be charged if any resident is found using cooler without permission and necessary payment.
- xii) Loud music is not allowed in the hostel premises.
- xiii) Residents are not at all allowed to create any type of disturbance/discomfort to fellow residents.
- xiv) No resident shall misbehave/indulge in manhandling with any of the hostel workers/fellow residents/hostel staff. Strict disciplinary action, including expulsion from the hostel/University, will be taken against the defaulter.
- xv) All rooms (including almirahs and belongings) are open for inspection by the Chief Warden/ Deputy Chief Warden/Warden at any time.
- xvi) Any resident found in possession of weapons shall be liable to a fine of Rs. 500/- and or expulsion from the Hostel/University and the matter shall be reported to the police.
- xvii) Unauthorized breaking of locks/windowpanes is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be fined Rs. 500/-.
- xviii) No resident will indulge in any kind of unruly behaviour.
- xix) No resident is allowed to take news papers/magazines/sports items/equipments in her room without permission of the Warden.
- xx) No resident shall be involved in stealing any property belonging to fellow hostellers. Strict discplinary action shall be taken accordingly.
- xxi) Before leaving the hostel, every resident shall obtain clearance from the Warden/Supervisor and personally hand over the charge of the room and hostel property to the Supervisor of the hostel. A penalty of Rs. 500/- will be imposed on the defaulter.
- xxii) No resident is allowed to stand near the main gate of Abhilasha girls' hostels complex and nearby areas, without permission.
- xxiii) The residents are not allowed to entertain the guest/guardian in front or near girls' hostels. For this purpose, the visitors rooms of their hostels should be used with permission of the Warden/Supervisor.
- xxiv) The residents are not allowed to entertain any lady guest including mother and sisters in their rooms at night, without permission.
- All residents are required to clear their Hostel, Mess, Canteen and other dues and obtain a "No Dues Certificate" before they take their examination roll number and again all their dues must be cleared before they vacate the hostel. For this purpose every resident has to deposit in Mess advance Rs. 4000/- as dues of mess charges for the month or, failing that, their names will be forwarded to the Registrar/Head of the Dept. for withholding the declaration of results/ award of degrees. Other disciplinary action, including forfeiture of securities, may also be taken.
- xxvi) If a resident comes late without permission she will be fined Rs. 100/- for 1st time and Rs. 200/- for IInd time. After that she will be expelled from the hostel.
- xxvii) Acts of indiscipline shall be severely dealt with. The Chief Warden/Warden will send such a case to the Head of the Dept. concerned for further disciplinary action.

- xxviii) The residents are not allowed to remain out of Hostel premises after the closure of Hostel main gate, except under exceptional circumstances and after obtaining permission of parents/HOD and Chief Warden (Girls). However Hostel Authority will not be responsible in case of any mishappening.
- xxix) If any resident wants to make any representation to the Chief Warden, she should make it through proper channel i.e. through the Warden of the concerned Hostel.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- i) All columns have been filled in with correct information particularly the residential address.
- ii) If the factor of residential address is found fake to conceal the distance, the admission will be cancelled immediately.
- iii) Hostel admission form of the candidate duly filled in and attested by the Head of the Department/ Institute concerned.
- iv) Hostel admission will be based on the merit list provided by the Head of the Department/ Institute concerned.
- v) Six latest passport size photographs, Ration card and Aadhar card copy of the candidate submitted at the time of admission.
- vi) An attested photo copy of last attended University examination from the HOD concerned.
- vii) A guest list along with the photograph of the parents and their relatives attested by the parents to be submitted by the parents at the time of admission of the candidate.
- viii) Students with criminal background will not be allowed admission in Girls Hostel.

Note:

- If any resident wants to avail the facility of desert cooler in her room they have to pay 200/- per month in advance as cooler charges after obtaining the permission of the Warden.
- The fees from residents will be charged for entire academic session.
- In exceptional cases on the recommendation of the HOD/Director of the respective department/institute/Centre etc., the Chief Warden may allow the resident to stay beyond the academic session, on payment of guest charges.
- The Vice- Chancellor may on the recommendation of the Chief Warden exempt blind students from the payment of all hostel charges.
- In case a student joins/leaves the hostel in mid-session, she will pay common room establishment and utensils/furniture charges for entire academic session and not for specific period of her stay in the hostel
- The hostel fees for Research Scholars/M.Phil/M.Ed. students whose admissions are usually not done alongwith other PG classes be taken from the month of admission on yearly basis.
- Hostel Fee is not refundable in any case.

RULES FOR WORKING WOMEN

- i. The fee charges from the working women will be same as charged from the other hostel residents till further orders. Accommodation charges will be deducted only after the assurance of Supdt. Bill for HRA deduction from their salary.
- ii. All rules and regulations will be same.

VISITORS AND GUESTS

- i. The visitors are allowed to visit only after making an entry in the Visitors' Register after taking due permission from the Warden.
- ii. No, visitor, in any case, shall be allowed to see the girl resident after the closer of main gate of girls' hostels.
- iii. Only those guests will be allowed to see a resident whose names are included in the approved guest list submitted at the time of admission.
- iv. Guests will be allowed to meet the resident only in the Visitor's Room.

ACCOMMODATION CHARGES FOR GUESTS

 Rs. 50/- per day per head (only for exam days.)

If any outsider is found in the resident's room, the resident will be fined @ of Rs. 500/and may even be expelled

v) Lunch Rs. 50/- (+ Rs. 5/- Service Charge)
vi) Dinner Rs. 50/- (+ Rs. 5/- Service Charge)
vii) Special Diet Rs. 100/- (+ Rs. 5/- Service Charge)

- Note: 1. Rs. 50/- per head, per day shall be charged from the guests and participating teams/individuals whose stay arrangements are made in the hostels on the request of host deptt./office as accomodation charges in advance. The host Deptt./office shall be responsible for the payment.
 - 2. The amount of guest charges shall be deposited in the Registrar Share/Fund.
 - 3. Mess Charges for the guests will be fixed by the Chief Warden from time to time, if necessary.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE

- i) No resident is allowed to leave the hostel during night except in emergency. She can go with her parents/relatives whose photos are in the approved guest list by the parents submitted at the time of admission with the permission of the Warden/Supervisor. Any resident found violating this rule will be liable to be expelled from the hostel/University and or fine upto Rs. 100/- will be charged.
- ii) In case if a resident comes late to the hostel (without information/permission) or absents herself in the night from hostel without prior permission, the hostel Warden will immediately inform the parents of such girl student and may take disciplinary action, if required.
- iii) No resident is allowed to leave the hostel during night or early morning except in emergency. She can go with her parents/relatives whose photos are in the approved Guest List.
- iv) In special cases, if the residents are required to leave the station, written prior permission of the Head of the Department/Institute concerned should be submitted to the Warden.
- v) A resident, under all circumstances, shall inform the Warden about her absence from the hostel. She shall sign the register maintained for the purpose at the hostel gate.
- vi) At the time of roll call the residents must show their Hostel-I card to the concerned Hostel Attendant.
- vii) Residents in girls' hostels shall present themselves in person for daily roll-call on the timings notified from time to time. Attendance will be taken by the Warden/Supervisor. Defaulters will be marked absent and fined accordingly. Strict disciplinary action, including expulsion from the hostel/University, will be taken against the defaulter.
- viii) The names of the residents absenting themselves without permission for a fortnight or more, may be struck off from the rolls and possession of their rooms will be taken by the Warden.
- ix) The hostel gate will Open at 5.30 a.m. and Close at the time mentioned below:-

April 1st to Sept. 30th - 8.00 p.m.
Oct. 1st to March 31st - 7.00 p.m.
Inter Hostel (Summer Time) - 10.30 p.m.
Inter Hostel (Winter Time) - 10.00 p.m.

- x) Late entry beyond specified time is not allowed in any case. However, in unforeseen circumstances, the entry may be allowed with the permission of the Warden after telephonic discussion with their parents.
- xi) Hostel will be checked by the Warden at night daily.

HOSTEL MESS:

- i) Facility of cooperative mess is provided in all hostels. The membership of cooperative mess is compulsory for every resident. Every member will have to give an undertaking that she will shoulder the responsibilities and observe the rules of cooperative mess. Messes are run by the mess committees under the overall control of the Wardens.
- ii) All residents shall have to take food in the hostel.
- iii) Those resident take admission in the month of July they will have to pay whole month servant charges.
- iv) Mess Timings:

Breakfast 8.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. **Lunch** 1.00 p.m. to 2.30 p.m. **Dinner** 7.30 p.m. to 9.00 p.m

- v) Meals will not be served before/after the fixed hours.
- vi) Residents are not allowed to enter the cooking area.
- vii) Cooking in the rooms is strictly prohibited.
- viii) Meals will be served in the Dinning Room only.

- ix) 23 diets will be compulsory for every resident in a month if a resident remains on leave during the whole month. A minimum of **5 Diets** (except Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner) and servant charges will be charged for that period. If resident coming from the home and mark the attendance at night, the mess will be considered open from that time onwards.
- x) In case of illness the names of sick residents will be registered with the Supervisor to get the special light food cooked for them.
- xi) A register for on/off this will be available on the mess counter wherein the residents should enter the information about missing the meals so as to avoid wastage of food.
- xii) Mess charges will be paid by the 15th of each month. After this date a fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged upto 20th of each month and the resident will not be allowed to take meals thereafter. The fine for delay pertaining to hostel dues will also be charged on the same pattern as mess dues.
- xiii) If the total amount of mess dues of a resident exceeds the security deposited on the 20th of each month, she will not be eligible for mess services from 21st onwards.
- xiv) All complaints requiring immediate attention of the Warden should be made in writing through a member of Mess Committee.
- xv) The Chief Warden may expel a resident from the hostel, if any kind of dues to be paid by her remains unpaid for two consecutive months.
- xvi) All hostel and mess payments are to be made by cheque after certification by the hostel warden and Mess Committee and cash transactions are prohibited, all cash receipts are to be deposited in the bank within 24 hours. Hostel staff dealing with mess transactions found in possession of cash illegally, disciplinary action will be taken against her.

MESS SERVANT CHARGES

Rs. 450/- per student, per month will be charged as Mess Servant Charges.

N. B.:

Hostels will be closed during Diwali and Holi vacations.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- i) Living in hostel pre-supposes a high degree of integrity and conscientiousness as a member of community. It also entails a moral responsibility on a resident.
- ii) No damage should be done to hostel property.
- iii) Make every effort for peaceful co-existence and maintaining discipline and decorum.
- iv) Observe all hostel rules meticulously in letter and spirit.
- Note i) The Hostel Authorities may expel any resident at any time, if they are not satisfied with her health such as chronic disease or conduct.
 - ii) Any resident found violating these rules will be liable to be expelled from the hostel/University and /or fine upto Rs. 500/-
 - iii) Any other notification from time to time by the Chief Warden/Warden will be binding on the residents.
 - iv) Hostel rules can be changed at any time with the approval of Vice-Chancellor.
 - iv) The University authorities will have the right to get the hostel vacated or closed down as and when they feel the situation so warrants.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

The instruction for curbing ragging as conveyed by the UGC vide letter No. 1-15/2009 (ARC) pt. III dated 17th March, 2017, in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 8.5.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009 and also given in chapter X be adhered to strictly (UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009, UGC website: www.ugc.ac.in & the Haryana Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institution Ordinance 2012.

Ragging in educational institutions is banned and any one indulging in ragging is likely to be punished appropriately. The punishment may include expulsion/suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period or fine with a public apology. The punishment may also take shape of (i) withholding or withdrawing scholarships or fellowships and other benefits (ii) forfeiting campus placement opportunities or recommendations. (iii) debarring from appearing in any test or examination or other evaluation process (iv) debarring from representing the educational institution in any reasonal, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc. (v) withholding results (vi) suspension or explusion from hostel or mess (vii) cancellation of admisson (viii) lodging of FIR with the local police. If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not/cannot be identified, collective punishment can be awarded to act as a deterrent.

Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to any other students, indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in freshers or junior students or any type of abuse through electronic media or wrongful confinement, use of criminal force, assault as well as sexual offence, trespass, defamation or threat to defame will be deemed an act of ragging.

Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 24295/2004 in the matter of University of Kerala V/S Council of Principals, Colleges of Kerala and others has ordered that if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the Institution.
