MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE HELD ON 22.11.2021 AT 11:00 AM IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM ADJACENT TO THE REGISTRAR OFFICE, M.D.UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO CONSIDER THE VARIOUS ISSUES RELATING TO ADMISSIONS TO VARIOUS PROGRAMS.

The GRC considered the matters relating to admissions in various Programs and recommended as under:-

1. The Committee considered the request dated 22.07.2021 made by Mr. Gurdeep for admission to Ph.D. Program in Poltical Science for the session 2020-21 and resolved that:

The Head, Department of Political Science shall supply duly certified copy of the roaster register for the session 2019-20 and 2020-21 alongwith detailed comments and a list of the students admitted in Ph.D. Program during the session 2020-21 within a week. After receipt of requistie information, the case be placed before GRC in its next meeting.

2. The Committee considered the recommendations of the Director Sports and HOD Law in respect of Meenakshi Sheoran for Admission to LLM (Shift-1) under supernumerary seats (sports category) for the session 2021-22.

After discussing the matter in detail, the Committee resolved that the admission of above named candidate for the session 2021-22 in the Department of Law be regularized in the light of comments of Director (Sports).

The Committee further observed that as per decision of the GRC taken in its meeting held on 29.10.2021, the Director, Sports should have sent his comments to the academic branch instead of HOD, Law. After seeking the comments of the Director, Sports the matter was to be reffered to the GRC for consideration by the Head, Department of Law. Therefore, the Committee viewed the matter seriously and resolved that the Hod (Law) and Director, (Sports) be informed accordingly that in future the recommendations of the GRC be followed strictly.

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3. The Committee considered the recommendation of the Admision Committee of Department of Commerce regarding the request of Mr. Puneet Sharma for conversion of seat into Supernumarary (Sports) for admission in M.Com Course.

The Committee resolved that the HOD (Commerce) may seek the comments of the Director, Sports and if the candidate is found eligible for Admission under Sports Quota, the HOD may make admission of the candidate upto 30th November, 2021.

4. The Committee considered the various requests of the HODs/ Students for extending the date for accepting the fee online of intermediates semesters (3rd, 5th, 7th & 9th Semester as the case may be) of year Integrated Programms and PG Programms runnin the UTD and MDU-CPAS.

The Committee resolved that the date be extended upto 30th November, 2021 with charging of late fee of Rs. 1000/- and further resolved that no further extension be given on any ground to such students. Earlier the date was prescribed upto 10.11.2021 without late fee.

 The Committee considered the request of Head, Deptt. of Bio-Chemistry for holding final physical counselling on 24th November, 2021 for three vacant seats in M.Sc. Biochemistry.

The Committee resolved that where the seats in 5 Year Integrated Programs (3 year, 4 year, 5 year & 6 year) and PG Programs (Two Year) vacant, the Physical Counselling be held on 29.11.2021 in the concerned Departments and the candidates be required to deposit the fee upto 30.11.2021. No admission will be allowed after the final cut off date i.e. 30.11.2021.

 The Committee considered the request of Mr. Parveen Kumar and Ms Ritika Ahlawat regarding giving him/her the benefit of fee concession in admission in Diploma in Digital Marketing as he belongs to SC category and ward of employee respectively.

The Committee resolved that provisions of the Prospectus be followed in the matter, which is as reproduced as under:-

"There is no relaxation in fee of students of any category as the Certificate/Diploma programs are offered under Self Financing Scheme and these are not degree programs. However, the University employees/their wards/spouses including the wards of retired employees and wards of employees who die in harness shall be entitled to 50% concession on the total fee."
