Why rule change in BBMB has become a flashpoint between Centre and Punjab

POLITICAL PARTIES in Punjab, barring the BJP, are up in arms over the Centre's decision to amend the rules regarding appointments to two key positions on the Bhakra MAN AMAN SINGH CHHINA ex plains the history of the BBMB, the changes that have been made and the apprehensions of the political parties and farmers of the state

Howdid BBMB come to be set

up? The genesis of BBMB lies in the Indus Water Treaty signed be-tween India and Palástan in 1960 whereby waters of three eastern rivers— Ravi, Beas and Sutlej— were allotted to India for exclusive use while Indus, Chenab and Jhelum rivers were allocated to

Jhelum rivers were allocated to Pakistan.

In India, a mast er plan was drawn to harnessthe potential of these rivers for providing assured irrigation and flood control. Bhakra and Beas projects form amajor part of this plan anniverse stabilished as andwereestablished as a joint venture of the then undivided Punjab and

then undivided Punjab and Rajasthan. Following the reorganisation of Punjabon Noember 1, 1986, and the creation of the state of Haryana, the Bhakra Beas Management Board was consti-tuted under Section 79 of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966. The administration, maintenance and operation of Bhakra Nangal project was handed over to Bhakra Manage ment on October 1,1957 OnMay 11,51976 whenthe Beas Projects Works were com-pleted and handed over, the Beas Hojects Works were com-pleted and handed over, the Bhakra Management Board was renamed as Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMB). Since then, BBMB regulates sup-plyofwater and power to Purjah, Haryana, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi and Chandigarh.

What is the constitution of the BBMB management?

The BBMB management includes a chairperson and two

What changes have been made to the BBMB rules?
The Government of India issued a notification on February 23, 2022 to amend the BBMB Rules 1974. thereby changing the crite-ria for the selection of whole-time members of the Board. Newrules specify technical qualifications for the appointments and pave the for appointment of the members from across India and not only



Rewari gets 5,949 plaints, Charkhi Dadri 3,706, M'garh 3,500

REWARI, MARCH 1

As many as 15,655 farmers in four districts - Rewari, Mahendragarh, Charkhi Dadri and Bhiwani - have sought compensation for their crop loss due to hailstorm and inundation owing to unseasonal rain last week.

They have filed claim applications with local offices of the Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Department. All of them are enrolled in the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Beema Yojana (PMFBY).

Sources claim the number of distressed farmers is much more as merely one-third farmers get insurance cover under the PMFBY every year.

Rewari has topped the figure with 5,949 farmers lodging complaints about extensive damage to their standing wheat and mustard crops due



to the hailstorm. It is followed by Charkhi Dadri with 3,706, Mahendragarh with 3,500 and Bhiwani with 2500 complaints.

Under the PMFBY, the farmers are bound to file applications within 72 hours of the crop loss to get compensation from the insurance company. "Wheat and mustard crops under all five

blocks of Rewari district have been affected by hailstorm. Hence, we deputed officials in every block so that farmers do not have to face any issue in moving claim applications. Jatusana is a badly-affected block where a total 2,183 farmers have sought compensation followed by Rewari with 1,792 and Khol with 1,317
