PROGRAMS / AWARD OF URS IN THE SESSION 2021-22

The Committee deliberated on the various issues relating to admissions to Ph.D. Programs /Award of URS in the session 2021-22 and recommends as under:

1. Considered the requests of various applicants regarding change in application form from Ph.D. Program to URS and Vice-Versa for the session 2021-22.

RESOLVED THAT THE CANDIDATES WHO HAVE APPLIED FOR U.R.S. AND HAVE APPEARED IN THE INTERVIEW FOR ADMISSION TO PH.D. PROGRAM CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARMENT/INSTITUTE. SUCH CANDIDATES BE CONSIDERED BY THE DEPARTMENT CONCERNED FOR ADMISSION TO PH.D. PROGRAM FOR THE SESSION 2021-22 BY CREATING EXTRA SEATS, SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY OF SUPERVISOR IF THESE CANDIDATES STANDS HIGHER IN MERIT TO THE LAST ADMITTED CANDIDATE TO PH.D. PROGRAM IN THEIR RESPECTIVE CATEGORY.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE HOD/DIRECTOR CONCERNED SHALL MAKE THESE ADMISSIONS WITHIN A WEEK OF ISSUANCE OF MINUTES OF THIS GRC MEETING. STATE GOVT. RESERVATION POLICY AND THE ROASTER REGISTER MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT/INSTITUTE BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY WHILE MAKING THESE ADMISSIONS.

2. Considered the requests of students to submit the documents relating to weightage etc. at this stage as they could not upload the same earlier while filling online application form for admission to Ph.D. Program/ Award of URS 2021-22. RESOLVED THAT SUCH REQUESTS OF THE APPLICANTS BE NOT ACCEDED

PROGRAM FOR THE SESSION 2021-22 BY CREATING EXTRA SEATS, SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY OF SUPERVISOR.

THE HOD/DIRECTOR CONCERNED SHALL MAKE ADMISSIONS WITHIN A WEEK OF ISSUANCE OF MINUTES OF THIS GRC MEETING. STATE GOVT. RESERVATION POLICY AND THE ROASTER REGISTER MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT/INSTITUTE BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY WHILE MAKING THESE ADMISSIONS.

6. Considered the request received from Liaison Officer, SC Cell, MDU, Rohtak with regard to considering the relevant Departments as single entity with regard to reservation for admission to Ph.D. Program.

RESOLVED THAT THE PROPOSAL BE CONSIDERED BY THE PROSPECTUS PREPARING COMMITTEE FOR ADMISSION TO PH.D PROGRAM IN THE NEXT **SESSION i.e. 2022-23**

Considered the request received from the Department of Statistics to reduce one seat (From 3 to 2 seats) for admission to Ph.D. Program 2021-22 as one teacher has applied for VRS (Voluntary Retirement Scheme). Request of an applicant of Statistics may also be considered who has requested the University not to decrease one seat for admission to Ph.D. Program 2021-22.

- 8. Considered the request received from Ms. Nidhi Malik for admission to Ph.D. Program in the Department of Law under Supernumerary category of single Girl Child.
 - RESOLVED THAT THE REQUEST OF THE APPLICANT BE ACCEDED TO IN ANTICIPATION APPROVAL OF THE ADMISSION COMMITTEE. HOWEVER, FOR THE NEXT SESSION, SUCH PROVISION FOR SUPERNUMEARY SEAT FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD MAY BE CONSIDERED BY THE PH.D. ORDINANCE PREPARING COMMITTEE FROM THE NEXT SESSION ONWARDS ON THE PATTERN OF SUCH PROVISION IN THE P.G. ADMISSIONS.
- 9. Considered the request received from the Department of Bio Chemistry for increase in one seat for admission to Ph.D. Program 2021-22 and to consider the request of the Department for approval of 4th Counselling.

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RESOLVED THAT REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT BE ACCEDED TO. STATE GOVT. RESERVATION POLICY AND THE ROASTER REGISTER MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT/INSTITUTE BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY WHILE MAKING THESE ADMISSIONS.

Considered the request of Ms. Priyanaka Yadav, an applicant for admission to Ph.D. (Economics), who has complaint that her NET Certificate was not considered by the Department though she had uploaded the same while filling online application form. Considered the request of Ms. Shilpa, an applicant of Ph.D. (English), who has requested that the University should provide exemption for Ph.D./URS entrance test to GATE pass out students on the pattern of the exemption given to NET pass out students as both are conducted at National Level. RESOLVED THAT THE REQUEST OF THE APPLICANT BE NOT ACCEDED TO IN VIEW OF PH.D. ORDINANCE.

13. Considered the request of Head, Department of Law who has requested the University to increase 3 seats for admission to Ph.D. Program 2021-22. RESOLVED THAT THE REQUEST FOR INCREASE OF ONE SEAT ONLY IN THE DEPARTMNENT OF LAW BE ACCEDED TO.

14. Considered the request of Mr. Jitender, an applicant of Ph.D. (Microbiology), who has made complaint with the University that there is ambiguity in the merit list of the Ph.D. Program in the said Department. RESOLVED THAT IN VIEW OF THE COMMENTS OF THE HEAD, DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY, THE REQUEST OF THE CANDIDATE BE NOT ACCEDED

15. Considered the request of Mr. Amit Dalal, Wing Commander, who has submitted a representation in the University with regard to procedural lapse in the admission to Ph.D. (Education) 2021-22. RESOLVED THAT THE REQUEST OF THE CANDIDATE BE NOT ACCEDED TO

AS THE ADMISSION SCHEDULE WAS MADE AVAILABLE BY THE UNIVERSITY ON THE UNIVERSITY WEBSITE FOR INFORMATION OF ALL CONCERNED.

16. Considered the request of Mr. Nitish Kumar, an applicant of Ph.D. (Political Science), who has complaint that his selection has been ignored due to non-supply of SC category document though he has submitted the document of DSC category at the time of interview.

RESERVATION POLICY AND THE ROASTER REGISTER MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT/INSTITUTE BE FOLLOWED STRICTLY WHILE MAKING THE ADMISSIONS ON THESE SEATS.
 - THAT THE DEPARTMENTS/INSTITUTES SHOULD AVOID THE PRACTICE (ii) FOR SENDING THE REQUEST FOR INCREASE OF SEATS AFTER ISSUANCE OF PROSPECTUS.
 - THAT THE DEPARTMENTS/INSTITUTES SHOULD SEND THE SEAT (iii) MATRIX AS PER RESERVATION POLICY AND ROASTER REGISTER FOR ADMISSION TO PH.D. PROGRAM FROM THE SESSION 2022-23 ONWARDS WELL IN TIME FOR INCLUSION OF THE SAME IN THE PROSPECTUS.
