MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR HELD ON 11.03.2023 AT 12.00 M.D.UNIVERSITY, ROHTAK TO CONSIDER VARIOUS ISSUES RELATED TO ADMISSIONS

The Committee considered the various issues and made its recommendations as under:-

1. Considered the representations received from the Liaison Officer (SC/ST Cell), M.D.University, Rohtak and a number of grievances from students, teachers and other applicants that there is violation of the UGC guidelines and State Reservation Policy in Direct JRF admissions being made by the Departments/Institutes of the M.D.University, Rohtak.

THE COMMITTEE OBSERVED THAT THERE ARE PRACTICAL DIFFICULTIES IN MAINTANING SEPARATE ROSTER REGISTER AND CONDUCTING PH.D. COURSE WORK BY THE DEPARTMENTS/ INSTITUTES WHILE MAKING ADMISSION TO PH.D. PROGRAM THROUGH DIRECT JRF CATEGORY. THEREFORE, THE COMMITTEE RECOMMEDS THAT MATTER WITH REGARD TO REVISITING THE PROVISION OF THE DIRECT JRF ADMISSIONS TO PH.D. PROGRAM BE REFERRED TO THE PH.D. ORDINANCE PREPARING COMMITTEE, IN VIEW OF THE UGC GUIDELINES, 2022.

2. Considered the request of Mr. Gautam for registration to Ph.D. Program at this stage who left the Ph.D. Program after completing Ph.D. Course work in August, 2018. The Head, Department of Mathematics has strongly recommended for registration of Mr. Gautam to Ph.D. Program.

COMMITTEE RESOLVED THAT THE PROPOSAL OF THE HEAD, DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS MAY BE RECOMMENDED FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL.

3. Considered the Memo No. 322 dated 24.01.2023 received from the Principal, Govt. College, Faridabad for admission of Ms. Kalpana and Ms. Rashi Dalal in BBA (Lateral Entry) on the basis of such cases allowed by the University earlier. The eligibility for BBA (Lateral Entry) as per MDU Admission Brochure 2022-23 was as under:-

"Candidates who have passed Diploma in Business Management or an equivalent examination approved by the State Board of Technical Education, Haryana with atleast 45% marks in aggregate".

Ms. Kalpana possesses the Diploma in Banking Finance and Insurance, and Ms. Rashi Dalal possesses the Diploma in Architectural Assistantship.

On the basis of the eligibility, the R&S Branch declared the students 'Not Eligible'. Thereafter, the Principal, Govt. College, Faridbad was requested to inform as to how the College took the admissions when the students were not eligible. The Principal vide letter dated 24.01.2023 as referred above has informed that it has been done as per past practice being permitted by the MDU, Rohtak.

KEEPING IN VIEW OF THE FUTURE OF THE STUDENS, THE GRC RECOMMENDED THAT THE ADMISSIONS OF MS. KALPANA AND MS. RASHI DALAL MAY BE REGULARISED BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR IN ANTICIPATION APPROVAL OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT THE STUDENTS HAVE TO PASS THE DEFICIT PAPERS OF BBA 1ST YEAR, IF ANY, WITHIN THE MAXIMUM DURATION OF THE COURSE TO BE IDENTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE OF IMSAR. THIS IS ONE TIME MEASURE AND SHOULD NOT MAKE A PRECEDENT IN FUTURE.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT AN ADVISORY MAY BE ISSUED TO THE PRINCIPAL, GOVT. COLLEGE, FARIDABAD FOR MAKING THESE ADMISSIONS IN VIOLATION OF THE ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION TO BBA (LATERAL ENTRY) DURING THE SESSION 2022-23.

4. Considered the request of Mrs. Deepika Narwal, admitted to Ph.D. Program under NRI category in the Department of Commerce, for allowing her case for registration to Ph.D. Program through conducting RAC, DC and DRC in online mode as she is not able to appear physically.

RESOLVED THAT THE REQUEST OF MRS. DEEPIKA NARWAL FOR APPEARING IN RAC, DC AND DRC IN ONLINE MODE MAY BE ACCEDED TO TILL HER REGISTERATION PROCESS IS OVER. HOWEVER, AFTER REGISTRATION, SHE WILL ENSURE HER ATTENDANCE PHYSICALLY AS PER EXISTING PROVISIONS OF THE PH.D. ORDINANCE.
