71. To note the Moll signed between M.D.University, Rohtak and Institute of Chemistry, Slovak Academy of Sciences, Slovakia

On receiving a proposal from the Director, Research alongwith the draft MoU from the Director, Institute of Chemistry, Slovak Academy of Sciences, Slovakia, the Vice-Chancellor constituted a Committee under the chairmanship of the Dean Academic Affairs with regard to MoU between M.D.University, Rohtak and Institute of Chemistry, Slovak Academy of Sciences, Slovakia. The meeting of the Committee was held on 27.10.2022 in which the Committee recommended the MoU. The minutes of the Committee were placed before the Vice-Chancellor who has approved the same. The University conveyed its intent to sign the MoU.

Thereafter, an invitation was received from Institute of Chemistry, Slovak Academy of Sciences, Slovakia for signing the MoU at Slovakia (Annexure A/123 pages 687-688, already circulated). The Academic Council vide Reso. No. 28 in its meeting held on 07.12.2022 considered the above MoU and resolved as under:



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and executed Slovakia on this day of November of the year 2022 and between:

MAHARSHI DAYANAND UNIVERSITY, Delhi Road. near Delhi Bypass, Rohtak, Haryana 124001, India;

AND

INSTITUTE OF CHEMISTRY SLOVAK ACADEMY OF SCIENCES (hereinafter referred to as "ICSAS") whose address at Dúbravskácesta5807/9, 845 38 Bratislava, Slovakia both hereinafter referred to as "the Parties",

Considering their common concern in the cooperative projects on basic and applied studies based on mutual interest.

Pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulations in India and in Slovakia, as well as the procedures and policies of both governments concerning international scientific andtechnological cooperation;

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1. OBJECTIVE

The Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is intended to be a base for conducting collaborative research, to submit collaborative research projects, and to perform short- and long-term research stays and fellowships for PhD students, postdocs and experienced researchers.

ARTICLE 2. PARTIES' UNDERSTANDING

This MoU is intended only to provide the general principles and key terms for overall cooperation in joint research program between the Parties: the detailed implementation of provision of this MoU shall be conducted through project, research stays and fellowships agreements to be jointly developed and agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE 3. FORMS OF COLLABORATION

The collaborative activities may cover:

- 1. Short- and long-term research stays and fellowships for PhD students, postdocs and experienced researchers by providing free of cost boarding and lodging facilities by both the parties during the period of stay.
- 2. Exchange of samples and information;
- 3. Collaboration on mutual projects and other mutually interested activities as appropriate;
- 4. Other forms of collaboration as agreed by the Parties

ARTICLE 4. DISCLOSURE AND PUBLICATION

Either party shall not disclose to a third party any confidential data and information obtained from the other party, except when the prior written approval of the other party is obtained. Prior to approval of any publication of the result obtained from the joint research, the Parties shall review the result in order to protect the intellectual property rights.

ARTICLE 5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The rights to obtain any intellectual property right (hereinafter referred to as "IPR") for inventions jointly made by the Parties shall be vested in both parties' written approval. Share of the ownership of the IPR shall be determined according to the degree of contribution toward the invention. The conditions and detailed arrangement shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

Neither party shall disclose/publish any confidential information obtained from the joint research without prior written consent of the other party.

ARTICLE 7. FUNDING AND RESOURCES

The implementation of this MoU shall be subject to the availability of funds from the Parties. The Parties agree to seek financial resources from the respective ordinary budgets, and also to seek grant budgets on a case by case basis.

In case any issues that are not addressed in this MoU should arise, the Parties agree that they shall be resolved through negotiation in good faith. The parties further agree that any disputes between the Parties shall be settled as amicably as possible.

ARTICLE 9. VALIDITY, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

The MoU shall become effective and remain valid until 10 years from the date of its signing. If the Parties agree to continue the MoU beyond the date of expiration, the MoU shall be extended by written agreement of the Parties. Either Party may terminate the MoU by a written notice to the other party at least six months prior to the intended termination date. The provisions in Articles 4, 5, 6 shall remain in force after the termination of this MoU.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this MoU shall become effective as of the Date of signing and is executed in two identical counterparts which are equally valid.






