



India, France to jointly track Indian Ocean Region threats



New Delhi: India and France reiterated after another round of maritime cooperation dialogue, their strong commitment to upholding international law, supporting multilateralism, including through regional organisations, respect for sovereignty and territorial integrity, and protecting freedom of navigation.

Recalling in a joint statement their vision for a free and open Indian Ocean Region, first expressed in the 'Joint Strategic Vision of India-France Cooperation in the Indian Ocean Region' in 2015, India and France agreed to support free and secure access to sea lanes of communications through collaboration between their maritime assets and organisations.



China-built airport in Pak's Gwadar welcomes 1st flight

Islamabad: The first commercial flight landed at Pakistan's new Gwadar International Airport on Monday following a months-long delay in the opening of the Bay of Bengal facility in volatile Balochistan province.

The airport's opening was postponed from August to the end of 2024 due to a security review sparked by separatist militancy in Balochistan, in Pakistan's southwest. Then, on Jan 10, the airport was inaugurated, but this was the first time it had welcomed a commercial flight.

"Pakistan achieved a landmark moment in its aviation history on Monday as the first commercial flight successfully landed at the new Gwadar International Airport," it read, adding the new airport is poised to play a key role in connecting Pakistan to global markets and facilitating trade, tourism, and economic development.

PIA Flight PK-500 departed from Karachi at 3:30 am and touched down at the airport at 11:15 am, carrying 46 passengers. In a video shared by PIA, the PIA flight was seen being greeted by a crowd of people at the airport.

"The first time of the airport will not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government," the PIA said.
