NBER-e-PRAVESH-2025 (Online Counselling for Admissions to various Diploma Courses under National Board of Examination in Rehabilitation(NBER), New Delhi)

National Board of Examination in Rehabilitation (NBER) an adjunct body of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) invites online applications from the eligible candidates for admission to its various Certificate & Diploma Level Courses in Special Education and Disability Rehabilitation offered by RCI's approved Institutions/University Departments across the country. **Online admission to these Courses will be made through Centralised Online e-Counselling on the merit basis only.**

Eligibility conditions for admission:

Special Education Courses (D.Ed.Spl.Ed.): Those who have passed 10+2 or equivalent with 50% of marks in any stream are eligible.

Disability Rehabilitation Courses (D.H.L.S., D.P.O., D.R.T., D.H.A.E.M.T., D.C.E.&A.T.(VI), D.V.R.(ID), D.C.B.R.): 10+2 with PCM/PCB or its equivalent examination from a recognized Central/State Board of Education with minimum 50% marks. Please refer to the respective syllabus on RIC website for more information

Sign Language (DTISL Course): Only for deaf candidates, 10+2 or its equivalent from a recognized Central/State Board of Education with minimum 45% marks aggregate, Certificate of Disability (Deaf), proficient receptive and productive skills in ISL.

Appearing candidates at 10+2 level examination may also apply; provided they obtain minimum 50% marks at 10+2 exam otherwise their candidature shall be rejected. However, relaxation of marks at 10+2 level for candidates belonging to reserved category for admission to Diploma level courses will be applicable as per the policy of the concerned Central/UT's, State Govt.

Parents and Siblings of PwDs will be given preference in admission on the basis of percentage of disability with minimum 50% disability -5 marks and maximum 10 marks for 100% disability (applicable to the first blood relation only).

Admission Process Flow

1. Online Registration & Choice Filling

Candidates seeking admission in Rehabilitation Courses must first complete the Online Registration Process and submit their choices of institutes. This process includes the following 6 steps:

Online Registration Steps:

- Step 1: Register with Personal Details
- Step 2: Upload Educational Qualifications
- Step 3: Upload Photograph, Signature, and Relevant Documents
- Step 4: Pay the Registration Fee
- Step 5: Fill in Choices of Institutes/Courses
- Step 6: Print the Completed Application Form

2. Merit List & Result Declaration

NBER will prepare and display the Merit List and Seat Allotment Results based on the candidate's category, percentage of marks, and choice filling.

Results, including the Rank and Allotted Institute/Course, will be available on the candidate's dashboard.

3. Reporting & Admission to Institute

Candidates who are allotted a seat must report to the respective Institute/College within the specified time frame.

Failure to take admission within the deadline may result in loss of the allotted seat or lower priority in further counselling rounds.


